Sunday – [Psalm 2](#) [LSB 398 – Hail to the Lord’s Anointed](#)

1. Who is the Lord’s Anointed whom the kings of the earth are against? v. 2
2. Why does the Lord laugh at the kings of the earth? v. 4
3. Who is the Son whom the Lord begets? ([Acts 13:32-33](#), [Hebrews 5:5](#))
4. Those who do not honor the Lord’s Son perish, but who are blessed? v. 12

Monday – [Genesis 6](#) [LSB 613 – To Thee Omniscient Lord of All](#)

1. What does it mean that the sons of God married the daughters of men? v. 2
2. Why did God plan to judge the whole earth with a flood? v. 5-7, 11-13
3. Besides Noah, whom else did God find favor (was gracious) with? ([Luke 1:30](#))
4. Why was Noah a righteous and blameless man who walked with God? v. 9

Tuesday – [Genesis 7](#) [LSB 596 – All Christians Who Have Been Baptized](#)

1. Besides two of every animal, why did Noah take seven of every clean animal?
2. In the days of the flood, who alone remained in the Old Testament Church?
3. How is the flood a type of the Last Day judgment?
4. How is the flood a type of baptism?

Wednesday – [Genesis 8](#) [LSB 809 – Great Is Thy Faithfulness](#)

1. What does it mean that God “remembered” Noah? v. 1 ([Nehemiah 13:31](#))
2. What does the dove and olive branch symbolize for early Christians? v. 11
3. What did Noah do immediately after leaving the ark? v. 20
4. Why was the Lord pleased with the burnt offering? v. 21

Thursday – [Genesis 9](#) [LSB 575 – My Hope Is Built on Nothing Less](#)

1. After the flood, how did God limit man’s wickedness and violence? v. 5-6
2. What was God’s unconditional covenant (promise) to all the earth? v. 9-11
3. How is the rainbow an example of how God works sacramentally? v. 12-13
4. Though wicked man drowned, what indicated that sinful nature continued?

Friday – [Genesis 11](#) [LSB 500 – Creator Spirit, by Whose Aid](#)

1. How did the people sin by building a tower to the heavens? v. 4
2. How did the Trinity (“let us”) foil their plans and disperse them over earth?
3. When and how did God reverse the curse of Babel? ([Acts 2:1-11](#))
4. From which descendants of Noah would God send a Savior for wicked man?

Saturday – [Isaiah 2](#) [LSB 653 – In Christ There Is No East or West](#)

1. What time do “the latter days” refer to? v. 1
2. What does “Mountain of the Lord” and “Mount Zion” refer to? v. 2-3
3. Besides the Jews, who else will join this messianic kingdom?
4. What does “beating swords into plowshares” represent? v. 4

Answers for Daily Meditation on the Old Testament – Week 2

Sunday – [Psalm 2](#)

1. The Anointed One is the Messiah, the Christ.
2. The Lord enthrones His Anointed King who reigns over them and all the earth
3. Divinity only begets Divinity. The Lord’s only begotten Son is Jesus Christ.
4. Those who take refuge in Jesus are blessed. ([Matt. 5:11-12](#), [Matt. 25:34](#))

Monday – [Genesis 6](#)

1. Godly believers, descendants of Seth, intermarried with godless unbelievers.
2. Because of original sin, man was totally wicked, evil, corrupt, and violent.
3. The Lord found favor (was gracious) to the virgin Mary whose womb served as the ark of the Christ child.
4. Noah believed God’s promise to save through the ark and Christ. ([Heb. 11:7](#))

Tuesday – [Genesis 7](#)

1. After the flood, Noah sacrificed some of every clean animal as a type of Christ
2. 8 people: Noah, his wife, his sons - Shem, Ham, and Japheth - and their wives
3. On the Last Day God will again judge unbelief. ([Matt. 24:37-39](#), [2 Peter 2:5,9](#))
4. In Holy Baptism the old man drowns and dies, and the new man rises to new life. ([2 Peter 3:18-21](#))

Wednesday – [Genesis 8](#)

1. God does not forget us, but he begins to work for our good.
2. Baptism by the Holy Spirit and the resulting peace with God.
3. He sacrificed burnt offerings to the Lord as an act of worship.
4. It was a sacrament which atoned for sin like Christ’s sacrifice. ([Lev. 1:3-4](#))

Thursday – [Genesis 9](#)

1. God instituted human government to take life for life. ([Romans 13:1-4](#))
2. God would never again send a worldwide flood to destroy all flesh.
3. God joins His Word of promise to a visible element (rainbow) for a blessing.
4. Noah got drunk on his wine, Ham mocked him, and Noah cursed Ham’s son.

Friday – [Genesis 11](#)

1. They disobeyed God’s command to fill the earth and glorified themselves.
2. God cursed them with different languages to stop and disperse them.
3. Pentecost. The Holy Spirit enabled the apostles to preach in many languages
4. From Shem would descend Abraham, the Hebrew nation, and Christ the Lord

Saturday – [Isaiah 2](#)

1. It is the time of the New Testament Church after Pentecost. ([Acts 2:14-17](#))
2. Literally, Zion was the Temple Mount. Here it symbolizes God’s N.T. Church.
3. All nations (Gentiles), many peoples will be drawn to the Word of the Lord.
4. Peace among Christians of all nations in the N.T. Church. ([Luke 2:13-14](#))
