1. In whom does David trust and for what? v. 1, 6, 20
2. Trusting in God's mercy, what does David confess and request? v. 7, 11, 18
3. For what else does David pray? v. 4-5, 8-9, 12
4. Besides praying for himself, for whom else does David pray? v. 22

1. What is Joseph's purpose in all his secrecy & shenanigans with his brothers?
2. Are the brothers sorry, to whom, and for what? v. 16

1. Though Joseph's brothers were expecting revenge, what does he do? v.3, 15
2. Instead of blaming them, to whom does Joseph credit deliverance? v. 5-9
3. How does Joseph show his forgiveness of their sin? v. 10-11, 21-22
4. As Jacob rejoiced that his son was alive, in whom do we rejoice who is alive?

Wednesday – [Genesis 47](#) [LSB 775 – Be Present at Our Table, Lord](#)

1. How does Pharaoh bless Jacob's family? v. 5-6
2. What is ironic about Jacob blessing Pharaoh? v. 10
3. How is Pharaoh blessed by Jacob's family? v. 13-26
4. Why is it so important to Jacob to be buried with his fathers and not in Egypt?

Thursday – [Genesis 49](#) [LSB 821 – Alleluia! Sing to Jesus](#)

1. How is Jacob's prophecy fulfilled that Simeon and Levi will be scattered? v.7
2. How is it fulfilled that the scepter will not depart from Judah? v. 10
3. How is the blessing of Joseph fulfilled in his sons Ephraim & Manasseh? v.22f
4. What does it mean that Jacob was gathered to his people? v. 29, 33

Answers for Daily Meditation on the Old Testament – Week 8

Sunday – [Psalm 25](#)

1. David trusts in the LORD for His love, mercy, and deliverance.
2. David confesses his sin and guilt and requests God's pardon and forgiveness.
3. David prays for the LORD's teaching and instruction in His truth and ways.
4. He prays for the nation of Israel that God would redeem them from trouble

Monday – [Genesis 44](#)

1. Joseph is ascertaining if his brothers are repentant of their sin against him.
2. Judah confesses that God has found out their guilt of selling their brother Joseph into slavery and that they deserve to become slaves themselves.
3. Judah volunteers to take Benjamin's place for his sake and his father's.
4. Jesus Christ took our place, suffered, and died for our guilt on the cross.

Tuesday – [Genesis 45](#)

1. Joseph embraced his brothers, wept, and spoke kindly with them.
2. Joseph believes that his troubles were part of God's plan to save the nation.
3. Joseph promises to provide for them and their families during the famine.
4. We rejoice that, though Jesus died for our sins, He is now risen and alive.

Wednesday – [Genesis 47](#)

1. For Joseph's sake, Pharaoh gives them the best of the land for their flocks.
2. The lowly shepherd blesses the mighty king, the inferior blesses the superior.
3. Through Joseph's wise administration, Pharaoh gains all the money and land in Egypt with a continuing yearly tax of one fifth of all the produce.
4. He desires to be buried in the land God promised to him, Isaac, and Abraham

Thursday – [Genesis 49](#)

1. Simeon was absorbed into Judah; the Levites were priests in all the land.
2. From Judah would come the line of kings, culminating with Jesus Christ.
3. Each becomes a powerful tribe and receives a portion in the Promised Land.
4. Though his body is buried, Jacob's soul joins the saints in heaven.

Friday – [Genesis 50](#)

1. They embalm him, grieve for days, form a funeral procession, and bury him.
2. They humble themselves, confess their sin, and plead for forgiveness.
3. Joseph remembers God's forgiveness and grace in his life. ([Romans 8:28](#))
4. His faith in God's promise to give them the Promised Land. ([Hebrews 11:22](#))

Saturday – [Isaiah 12](#)

1. For Christ's sake, the LORD has turned from His anger to comfort us.
2. I am trusting Thee Lord Jesus . . .trusting Thee for full salvation great and free
3. Jesus provides a spring of water welling up to eternal life. ([John 4:14](#))
4. We give thanks to the Lord, pray, sing praise, and proclaim Him to the nations
