Answers for Daily Meditation on the Old Testament – Week 9

Sunday – [Psalm 32](#)

1. The one whose sin the LORD forgives, covers, & does not count against him.
2. Our spirit weakens, and we feel the heavy hand of the LORD against our guilt.
3. The LORD forgives the iniquity of our sin. (LSB 184)
4. We are glad, rejoice in the LORD, and shout for joy with an upright heart.

Monday – [Exodus 1](#)

1. The LORD is giving them many descendants.
2. The LORD multiplies and spreads His Church. ([Matthew 16:18](#))
3. God & His law must be obeyed over the law of human government. [Acts 5:29](#)
4. King Herod killed the baby boys of Bethlehem. ([Matthew 2:16-18](#))

Tuesday – [Exodus 2](#)

1. His mother is paid to nurse her own child & he grows up in Pharaoh's house.
2. Moses commits murder and must flee the country from Pharaoh.
3. The former prince of Egypt became a fugitive in a foreign land herding sheep
4. God keeps His promise to deliver us from the slavery of sin by His Messiah.

Wednesday – [Exodus 3](#)

1. It is the LORD God himself, mostly like the Son of God, the Word of God.
2. He sees their suffering & vows to bring them to the land promised Abraham.
3. Jesus said, "I AM the bread of life . . . the light of the world . . . the gate . . . the good shepherd . . . the resurrection . . . the vine . . . the way, truth, and light.
4. Through Moses, God strikes Egypt with plagues, and they exit with plunder.

Thursday – [Exodus 4](#)

1. The LORD gives Moses miraculous signs/miracles through the staff.
2. God promises to be with his mouth and gives Aaron to speak for him.
3. The LORD will kill Pharaoh's firstborn son (the tenth plague).
4. They believed God's promise and worshipped Him.

Friday – [Exodus 5-6:1](#)

1. That God's people may go to worship the LORD in the wilderness.
2. He denies their worship and punishes them with harsher labor.
3. Instead of Pharaoh, they blame Moses and ask the LORD to judge him.
4. That the LORD has brought evil to His people, that He sent the wrong guy, & that He hasn't delivered, but the LORD promises deliverance by His strong hand

Saturday – [Isaiah 25](#)

1. The kingdom of heaven where God invites all people to come. ([Mt. 22:1-10](#))
2. At the Resurrection, the Lord swallows up death forever. ([1 Cor. 15:54-57](#))
3. God wipes away tears of sorrow and the reproach of their sin. ([Rev. 7:13-17](#))
4. They will be glad and rejoice in the LORD's salvation.
