### Sunday – [Psalm 34](#)      [LSB 637 – Draw Near and Take the Body of the Lord](#)

1. In the Benedicamus, how can we sinners say, “Let us bless the Lord”? v. 1
2. After praising and seeking the LORD, how does the LORD respond? v. 4-7
3. When do we “taste and see that the LORD is good”? v. 8
4. Though Christians have many afflictions, what does the LORD do? v. 19-22

### Monday – [Exodus 12](#)      [LSB 633 – At the Lamb’s High Feast We Sing](#)

1. How was the Passover Lamb like Jesus? v. 5, 8, 13, 21, 23, 46
2. Why did the Israelites eat unleavened bread for the Passover? v.14-20,33-34
3. What promise did the LORD keep to Abraham? v. 35-41 ([Genesis 15:13-14](#))
4. Who ate the Passover meal, and who was not allowed to eat of it? v. 43-48

### Tuesday – [Exodus 13](#)      [LSB 918 – Guide Me, O Thou Great Redeemer](#)

1. How did the people remember God’s deliverance by the 10<sup>th</sup> plague?v.11-16
2. Who else brought their firstborn son to be consecrated to the LORD?
3. Instead of the short route to the Promised Land, where did God lead them?
4. How did the LORD go before the Israelites to lead them out of Egypt? v. 21f

### Wednesday – [Exodus 14](#)      [LSB 590 – Baptized into Your Name Most Holy](#)

1. What drove Pharaoh to change his mind and pursue the Israelites? v. 4-9
2. After God’s deliverance in the plagues, how did the people respond?v.10-12
3. How did the LORD fight for the Israelites? v. 14, 19-27.
4. How is the crossing of the Red Sea a type of baptism? v.28-31 ([1 Cor. 10:1-2](#))

### Thursday – [Exodus 15](#)      [LSB 487 – Come, You Faithful, Raise the Strain](#)

1. What is the first recorded Hymn of Praise recorded in the Bible? v. 1-18
2. In this praise hymn, who is the main subject driving all the verbs?
3. When the people grumbled against Moses, what did the LORD do? v. 23-24
4. What is bitter to us, but made sweet by a log?

### Friday – [Exodus 16](#)      [LSB 642 – O Living Bread from Heaven](#)

1. What is the Israelites’ complaint, and how did the LORD respond? v.2-3,9-12
2. How did the LORD fulfill His promise? v. 13-15
3. Instead of grumbling, how do we show faith in the LORD for our daily bread?
4. Who is the living bread come down from heaven of whom we eat & not die?

### Saturday – [Isaiah 42](#)      [LSB 817 – Earth and All Stars](#)

1. Who is God’s humble, gentle, beloved servant, who brings justice? v. 1-4
2. What does the LORD do for those He calls in righteousness? v. 6-7
3. Why does the LORD’s glory and praise surpass idols and false gods? v. 8-9
4. Who sings to the LORD a new song of praise? v. 10-12

## Answers for Daily Meditation on the Old Testament – Week 11

### Sunday – [Psalm 34](#)

1. The lesser person *praises* the greater person for his ability for success.
2. He answers and delivers as does “The angel of the LORD” (Christ). ([Dan. 6:22](#))
3. In Communion we take the body of the Lord into our mouth for forgiveness.
4. He delivers us from all afflictions and redeems those who take refuge in Him.

### Monday – [Exodus 12](#)

1. It was unblemished, its flesh was eaten by God’s people, its blood saves from death, it was killed for them, none of its bones were broken. ([John 19:33-37](#))
2. Left in haste before the dough could rise. Leaven is a symbol of sin, impurity.
3. After 400 years of slavery, his many descendants were freed with wealth
4. God’s people, the congregation of the Israelites but no uncircumcised person

### Tuesday – [Exodus 13](#)

1. All the firstborn of the animals belonged to God. The sons were redeemed.
2. Mary & Joseph brought their first son Jesus to the Temple. ([Luke 2:22-23](#))
3. Into the wilderness toward the Red Sea and Mt. Sinai (Horeb). ([Exodus 3:12](#))
4. The LORD guided them in a pillar of cloud by day and a pillar of fire by night.

### Wednesday – [Exodus 14](#)

1. The LORD hardened Pharaoh’s heart to bring glory to God in his defeat.
2. They cried out in fear of death, complained to Moses, & preferred servitude.
3. The angel of God in the pillar of cloud stood between the Egyptians and the Israelites. The LORD confused the Egyptians and drowned them in the Red Sea.
4. The unbelieving man drowns, but the believing man rises to live a new life.

### Thursday – [Exodus 15](#)

1. The song of Moses & Israelites praising the LORD for saving at the Red Sea.
2. The LORD casts, shatters, overthrows, blows, stretches, redeems, guides
3. He made the bitter water at Marah sweet by casting a log into the water.
4. The accusing Law is bitter, but the cross of Christ makes the Gospel sweet.

### Friday – [Exodus 16](#)

1. They hungered for the bread of Egypt, but the LORD promised bread & meat.
2. The LORD provided quail in the evening and bread (manna) in the morning.
3. We pray, “Give us this day our daily bread,” all we need for our body.
4. Jesus Christ gives us His body in the bread of Holy Communion. [John 6:47-58](#)

### Saturday – [Isaiah 42](#)

1. Jesus Christ, Son of God, anointed by the Holy Spirit. ([Matthew 12:15-21](#))
2. He takes our hand, opens our eyes, and frees us from the prison of darkness.
3. By His omniscience & omnipotence He declares the future & makes it happen
4. All who inhabit the earth, sea, coast, desert, and mountain top.
