Sunday – [Psalm 46](#) [LSB 656 – A Mighty Fortress Is Our God](#)

1. What turmoil in life is like the earth giving way and the waters roaring? v.2-3
2. Why should we not fear during such times? v. 1, 7, 11 ([Romans 8:31](#))
3. How does God dwell in the midst of His city as a refuge for sinners? v. 4-5
4. How does God bring peace to earth and still its turmoil? v. 6, 8-10

1. What did God command for the seventh day and seventh year? v. 10-12

4. What does the bread of the Presence on the Table foreshadow? v. 30

Thursday – [Exodus 31](#) [LSB 906 – O Day of Rest and Gladness](#)

1. Besides ability, what else did the LORD bless Bezalel with? v. 2-3
2. How did the LORD sanctify His people? v. 13
3. How was keeping the Sabbath a sign of God's creation? 16-17
4. How did God record the Commandments for Moses? v. 18

Friday – [Exodus 32](#) [LSB 908 – Lord, Open Now My Heart to Hear](#)

1. As God gave Moses worship instructions, what were the people doing? v.1-6
2. When God vowed to destroy the sinful people, what did Moses do? v. 7-14
3. How did Moses show his anger and punish the people for their idolatry? v.19f
4. Why were the Levites ordained for the service of the LORD? v. 25-29

Saturday – [Isaiah 44](#) [LSB 564 – Christ Sits at God's Right Hand](#)

1. How does the LORD show his superiority over false gods? v. 6-8
2. How does the LORD poke fun at him who crafts and worships idols? v. 14-19

Answers for Daily Meditation on the Old Testament – Week 13

Sunday – [Psalm 46](#)

1. Turmoil caused by calamity, cancer, death of a loved one, satanic assaults.
2. God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble, our fortress.
3. In the flesh of Jesus in our worship on earth and in heaven. ([Rev. 22:1-5](#))
4. The LORD's judgement on the nations ultimately brings peace to His people.

Monday – [Exodus 23](#)

1. Rest for the land, people, poor, servant, and beast. ([Matthew 11:28-30](#))
2. Not their leftovers, but the best of the first fruits which God had given them.
3. The angel of the LORD who bears the name of the LORD. (The Son of God)
4. So they would not be tempted to sin and worship false gods.

Tuesday – [Exodus 24](#)

1. "All that the LORD has spoken we will do, and we will be obedient."
2. They could approach and see God and eat and drink in His presence.
3. God promised to forgive our sins through the blood of Jesus. ([Mt. 26:26-28](#))
4. At the Lord's Table when we eat and drink the flesh and blood of Jesus.

Wednesday – [Exodus 25](#)

1. When they left their bondage, they plundered the Egyptians (backpay).
2. A place where God would dwell in His grace in the midst of His people on earth like He does in heaven. ([Hebrews 8:1-7](#))
3. Christ is the propitiation (mercy seat sacrifice) for our sins. ([Rom. 3:23-25](#))
4. Jesus Christ is present in the bread of the Lords' Table for us to eat.

Thursday – [Exodus 31](#)

1. The Holy Spirit enabled Bezalel to complete the details of the Tabernacle.
2. The LORD makes His people holy through His gifts in worship on the Sabbath.
3. It reminded them that God created the world in 6 days and rested on the 7th.
4. God wrote the Commandments on two tablets of stone with His own finger.

Friday – [Exodus 32](#)

1. They made up their own worship with a golden calf like the Egyptians.
2. Moses interceded & reminded God of His promises to Abraham, Isaac, Jacob
3. He broke the tablets of the covenant & ground the golden calf in their water
4. They rallied to the LORD's side and followed Moses' word.

Saturday – [Isaiah 44](#)

1. Only the LORD can declare what is to come and make it happen.
2. From the same piece of wood he cooks his supper & carves an idol to worship
3. The LORD has blotted out our sins and redeemed us by the blood of Jesus.
4. Isaiah lived before the exile of Judah, but the LORD prophesied that King Cyrus of Persia would decree their return to rebuild the Temple and Jerusalem.
