Answers for Daily Meditation on the Old Testament – Week 14

Sunday – [Psalm 50](#)

1. Asaph was one of the Levites David appointed to provide music for worship.
2. God comes in fire and tempest to judge His people in righteousness.
3. God desires our sacrifice of thanksgiving for bestowing His salvation in Christ.
4. God promises to deliver us, and we will glorify Him for it.

Monday – [Exodus 33](#)

1. No one could stand in the presence of a holy God, see His face, and live.
2. The pillar of cloud was a theophany of God, namely the Son of God.
3. God put Moses in a cleft of a rock so he could see His back as He passed by.
4. Moses saw the glory of God in Jesus Christ on the Mount of Transfiguration.

Tuesday – [Exodus 34](#)

1. Moses cut two more stone tablets and rewrote God's Ten Commandments.
2. The LORD will not clear the guilty, but He is also a merciful and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in steadfast love, and forgiving iniquity and sin.
3. To be among them, pardon their sin, and take them as His inheritance.
4. The skin of his face shone because he had been talking with God.

Wednesday – [Exodus 35](#)

1. Whoever had a generous heart was to bring a freewill offering to the LORD.
2. Everyone whose spirit moved him & had a willing heart brought an offering.
3. The LORD had delivered them from bondage in Egypt, had given them plunder from the Egyptians, and was bringing them to the Promised Land.
4. God filled Bezalel and Oholiab with His Spirit, skill, and craftsmanship.

Thursday – [Exodus 36](#)

1. Moses restrained the people from giving for there was more than enough.
2. Acacia wood, fine linen, colored yarn, bronze, silver, and gold.
3. Marble, brass, stained glass, silver plate, fine linen paraments and banners.
4. The heavenly city Jerusalem where we will dwell forever. ([Rev. 21:9-21](#))

Friday – [Exodus 40](#)

1. The ark of the covenant, table of show bread, altar of incense, lampstand.
2. The altar of burnt offering for sacrifices and bronze basin for washing.
3. They were anointed with oil and given holy garments to wear.
4. The glory of the LORD in a pillar of cloud and fire.

Saturday – [Isaiah 45](#)

1. Cyrus is the King of Persia who conquered Babylon during the Israelite exile.
2. Cyrus makes the decree which frees the Israelites and rebuilds Jerusalem.
3. God hides His Divinity in Jesus' flesh and His flesh & blood in bread & wine.
4. All the ends of the earth, the Gentiles as well as the Jews.
