1. After David commits adultery with Bathsheba, what does he confess? v. 1-4
2. Besides his actual sins, what else is David guilty of? v. 5
3. Besides blotting out his sin, what else does David desire God to do? v.10-12
4. What is David able to do after repentance and turning back to God? v. 13

Monday – [Leviticus 8](#) [LSB 682–God of the Prophets, Bless the Prophets’ Sons](#)

1. Who was present for the ordination of Aaron and his sons as priests? v. 3-4
2. What identified the one who would hold the office of high priest? v. 5-12
3. What was the purpose of the sacrifice and sprinkling Aaron with blood? v.34
4. Who was anointed with the Holy Spirit to be our high priest? ([Hebrews 3:1](#))

Tuesday – [Leviticus 9](#) [LSB 431 – Not All the Blood of Beasts](#)

1. What was the purpose of Aaron making the sin offering & burnt offering? v.7
2. How were these sacrifices like a New Testament Sacrament?
3. What was the purpose of the peace offering? v. 18 ([Leviticus 19:5-6](#))
4. How was the peace offering like the Lord’s Supper?

Wednesday – [Leviticus 10](#) [LSB 507 – Holy, Holy, Holy](#)

1. Why did the LORD consume the sons of Aaron, Nadab & Abihu with fire? v.1
2. When were the priests not to indulge in wine or strong drink? v. 9
3. Why were they to distinguish between holy & common, clean & unclean?
4. How might you honor God’s presence and holiness in Divine worship?

Thursday – [Leviticus 16](#) [LSB 550 Lamb of God](#)

1. When was the only time that Aaron could enter the most holy place? v. 2-5
2. What did Aaron do with blood of the first sacrificial goat? v. 15-17
3. What did Aaron do with the second goat, the scapegoat? v. 21-22
4. After His baptism, how was Jesus like the scapegoat? ([Mark 1:9-13](#))

Friday – [Leviticus 18](#) [LSB 701 – Draw Us to Thee](#)

1. What did the LORD command concerning the life of the Israelites? v. 1-5
2. What evil practice of the Canaanites did God prohibit? v. 21
3. Besides incest and adultery, what else was an abomination to God? v. 22-23
4. What would happen if the Israelites did sexual abominations? v. 24-30

Saturday – [Isaiah 49](#) [LSB 471 – O Sons and Daughters of the King](#)

1. Whom does the LORD call and name from the womb to deliver Israel? v. 1,5
2. What was too light a thing for the LORD’s servant to do? v. 6
3. When we feel forsaken by God, what should we remember? v. 14-16

Answers for Daily Meditation on the Old Testament – Week 15

Sunday – [Psalm 51](#)

1. David confesses his actual sin against God and his need for God’s mercy.
2. David confesses his original sin from conception, that is his sinful nature.
3. Create a clean heart & right spirit in him & take not the Holy Spirit from him.
4. Then David can teach other transgressors to return to God and learn His ways

Monday – [Leviticus 8](#)

1. The LORD told Moses to assemble all the congregation at the Tabernacle.
2. The high priest wore holy vestments and was anointed with oil.
3. To make atonement or satisfaction to God for his sins.
4. Christ (the Anointed One) intercedes for us & atones for our sin on the cross.

Tuesday – [Leviticus 9](#)

1. To make atonement or satisfaction to God for his sins & the sins of the people
2. God joins His Word of promise to a visible element for the forgiveness of sins
3. The flesh from the sacrifice was to be eaten by the priests and Israelite families as a meal for holy communion with God.
4. In the bread we eat Christ’s flesh sacrificed on the cross & commune w/ God.

Wednesday – [Leviticus 10](#)

1. Because they offered unauthorized fire in a censor. God does not tolerate man’s arbitrary worship procedures but provides ordinances for worship.
2. Before or during the time they carried out their liturgical duties for worship.
3. All rituals were to protect God’s people from desecrating His holiness.
4. By your attire, cleanliness, speech, behavior, attention, and reverence.

Thursday – [Leviticus 16](#)

1. The Day of Atonement (Yom Kippur), washed & wearing the holy garments.
2. He sprinkled it over the mercy seat to make atonement for sins.
3. He confessed over it the sins of the people & sent it to the wilderness to die.
4. As the sinner bearer of the world, the H.S. drove Him into the wilderness.

Friday – [Leviticus 18](#)

1. Not to walk in the ways of the Egyptians & Canaanites but the way of LORD.
2. The killing and sacrifice of their children to the god, Molech.
3. Homosexual acts and bestiality. ([Romans 1:26-27](#))
4. The LORD would punish their iniquity & they would be vomited from the land

Saturday – [Isaiah 49](#)

1. While in Mary’s womb, the angel named Jesus which means “the Lord saves”
2. To redeem only Israel. Christ would also bring salvation to the Gentiles.
3. Like a mother her child, God will not forget us. He engraves us on His hands.
4. Christ bears the scars of the cross on His hands as a mark of His love for us.
