Answers for Daily Meditation on the Old Testament – Week 17

Sunday – [Psalm 67](#)

1. The Lord bless you. The Lord make His face shine on you & be gracious to you
2. They praise God for His universal grace and salvation for all nations.
3. God judges the people with equity. He judges us to be justified by Jesus Christ
4. God provides our daily bread through the fruits of the earth.

Monday – [Numbers 6:22-27, 10:11-36](#)

1. In our baptism and in the Benediction of the Divine Service
2. They were 1 year at Sinai building the Tabernacle, learning God's commands
3. Hobab the son of Reuel (Jethro) the Midianite, the Father-in-Law of Moses.
4. The Lord led them in the visible pillar of cloud and the ark of the covenant.

Tuesday – [Numbers 11](#)

1. That God would kill him because of the people's burdensome complaints.
2. Moses appoints 70 elders upon whom God puts His Spirit to carry the burden
3. He wishes that the LORD would put His Spirit on all His people.
4. At our baptism, the Holy Spirit creates in us a new heart and gives us faith.

Wednesday – [Numbers 12](#)

1. They thought that they, too, should have the office of prophet.
2. God spoke to the prophet in a vision or dream.
3. God spoke to Moses clearly, mouth to mouth and face to face.
4. She becomes leprous and must remain outside the camp for 7 days.

Thursday – [Numbers 13](#)

1. To first send 12 men to spy out the land which He was *giving* the Israelites.
2. The land was good, but the people were large and dwelled in fortified cities.
3. Caleb of Judah believed the LORD & encouraged the people to take the land.
4. That they were not able to take the land from the large, strong inhabitants.

Friday – [Numbers 14](#)

1. Do not fear & rebel against the LORD for the LORD is with us & gives the land.
2. Moses interceded for the people and prayed to the LORD to remember His promise to show His love by forgiving their sin and pardoning their iniquity.
3. Except for Joshua & Caleb, because of unbelief no one over 20 would enter the promised land but die in the wilderness. The other 10 spies died by plague.
4. The LORD was not with them so they were defeated.

Saturday – [Isaiah 52](#)

1. The preaching of the Gospel of Jesus Christ which gives faith. [Rom. 10:14-17](#)
2. Beginning in Christ's ministry ([Luke 3:3-6](#)) and in His death and resurrection.
3. When Jesus was so badly beaten in His passion that His face was disfigured.
4. When Jesus rose and ascended in glory, and when He returns to judge all.
