Answers for Daily Meditation on the Old Testament – Week 19

Sunday – [Psalm 91](#)

1. The Almighty God is our shelter, refuge, & fortress in who's shadow we abide
2. This year from a COVID-19 epidemic but ultimately from the plague of death.
3. To guard you and bear you up lest you strike your foot against a stone.
4. The devil tempted Jesus to jump off the Temple, but Jesus wouldn't test God.

Monday – [Numbers 24](#)

1. By the Spirit of God, Balaam hears the words of God and blesses Israel.
2. In 400 years when King Saul of Israel defeats King Agag of the Amalekites.
3. No matter the compensation, Balaam can only speak what the LORD speaks.
4. In 1400 years when the star of Bethlehem leads the wise men to King Jesus.

Tuesday – [Numbers 25](#)

1. By adultery with Moabite women & idolatry of Baal, they brought God's anger
2. The idolaters were killed and hung in the sun as a warning to the people.
3. To make atonement to God, Phinehas pierced the defiant pair with a spear.
4. Jesus was hung on a cross and a spear pierced his side in death.

Wednesday – [Numbers 27](#)

1. God is merciful & grants them and others a possession in the Promised Land.
2. Before Moses dies, God lets him see the Promised Land from a mountain top
3. That God appoint a man to serve and lead them as their shepherd after him.
4. Joshua is full of God's Spirit and has served as Moses aid for 40 years. The high priest lays hands on him and invests him with authority over the people.

Thursday – [Numbers 32](#)

1. That they inherit the land east of the Jordan River and not cross over it.
2. They neglect their duty to the other tribes & show unbelief like their fathers.
3. They will send their armed men across to fight until all Israel inherits the land
4. They would inherit the land east of the Jordan or suffer for their sin.

Friday – [Numbers 35](#)

1. 48 cities in which to dwell with surrounding acreage for pastureland.
2. The Levites are dispersed among the tribes to preach and teach God's Word.
3. Those who killed by accident could flee for refuge there and await a just trial.
4. We flee to Christ who protects us from death and the accusations of the devil. By the death of our high priest, Christ atones for our sin so we may live.

Saturday – [Isaiah 55](#)

1. By Christ's payment on the cross, the Gospel calls all to come to His banquet.
2. Because of Christ, God will have compassion and pardon their sin.
3. We remember that God's thoughts & ways are beyond our comprehension.
4. God's Word is not wasted but accomplishes His purposes for our salvation.
