1. For what do we praise the LORD and what benefits do we not forget? v. 2-5
2. Instead of condemning our sins, what does God do with our sins? v. 10-12

4. Though we still sin, why does God remove and forgive our sin?

4. What N.T. prophet did miraculous wonders and taught God's Word purely?

1. What was the purpose of the dietary laws? v. 3-21
2. When was this dietary restriction & ceremonial law removed? [Mark 7:15-23](#)

4. What else was the tithe to be used for and why? v. 27-29

1. Since the Levites received no land, what was their inheritance? v. 1-5
2. What were some of the abominable practices forbidden by God.? v. 9-14
3. After Moses, what office does God institute to speak His Word? v. 15-22
4. In whom does the office of prophet find its fulfillment? ([Acts 3:19-23](#))

Saturday – [Isaiah 65](#) [LSB 673 – Jerusalem, My Happy Home](#)

1. What will the LORD do to a rebellious, idolatrous people? v. 1-7
2. What will the LORD do for those who seek and serve the LORD? v. 8-10
3. What will not be part of the new heavens and earth? v. 19-20
4. What blessings will we receive in heaven? v. 17-18, 21-25

Answers for Daily Meditation on the Old Testament – Week 22

Sunday – [Psalm 103](#)

1. The LORD's forgiveness, healing, redemption, love, mercy, and goodness.
2. Because of His love, God removes our sins as far as the east is from the west.
3. God loves us like a father shows compassion on his children.
4. Because God is merciful and because of Jesus' atoning sacrifice for sinners.

Monday – [Deuteronomy 11](#)

1. Consider the LORD's discipline, love Him, and keep His Commandments.
2. It was a fertile, watered land, flowing with milk and honey.
3. They wore [phylacteries](#), taught their children, and marked their homes.
4. Moses read the Law of the LORD, its blessings and curses. ([Joshua 8:33-34](#))

Tuesday – [Deuteronomy 12](#)

1. Destroy, tear down, dash, & burn them to remove the name of the false god
2. Not where they chose, but where God chose to put His name. (The Temple)
3. Not the blood because the life is in the blood.
4. Take, drink, this is the true blood of our Lord Jesus Christ, shed for you.

Wednesday – [Deuteronomy 13](#)

1. The people were not to listen to him but put him to death & follow the LORD.
2. They were not to be heard, spared, concealed, or pitied but stoned to death.
3. The whole city was to be put to death by the sword and burned.
4. Jesus miraculously healed & fed people and cast out demons as He preached.

Thursday – [Deuteronomy 14](#)

1. For the Israelites' bodily health to avoid animals which might carry disease and for their spiritual health to avoid table fellowship with pagan Gentiles.
2. When Jesus declared all foods clean and mission work began. [Acts 10:9-23](#)
3. As part of their worship at the Temple to eat as a festival meal.
4. For support of Levites, orphans, and widows to receive the LORD's blessing.

Friday – [Deuteronomy 18](#)

1. The LORD and the offerings which the people tithed and gave in worship.
2. Those who sacrificed their children, fortune tellers, sorcerers, and mediums.
3. The office of prophet. God would put His Words in his mouth to speak.
4. In Jesus Christ of whom God said on the mount we should listen. [Mt. 17:4-5](#)

Saturday – [Isaiah 65](#)

1. The LORD will repay their iniquities and destroy them with His judgement.
2. The LORD will deliver the remnant and give them possession of His blessings.
3. Weeping, distress, and death. ([Revelation 21:1-4](#))
4. Joy, gladness, satisfaction in work for habitation and harvest, the presence of the LORD, peace.
