Answers for Daily Meditation on the Old Testament – Week 23

Sunday – [Psalm 110](#)

1. The LORD (Yahweh) says to my Lord (Jesus Christ). God says to His Son.
2. “Sit at my right hand.” He sits at the right hand of God the Father Almighty.
3. Jesus is our priest who hears our prayers and intercedes for us before God.
4. Judge the nations. From thence He will come to judge the living and the dead

Monday – [Deuteronomy 26](#)

1. They were to bring the first fruits of the land as an offering in worship.
2. That God had delivered them from oppression and brought them to this good land.
3. The Levites (church workers), sojourners (homeless), orphans, and widows.
4. That they will be His treasured possession and set apart as His holy people.

Tuesday – [Deuteronomy 28](#)

1. The LORD promises to give us temporal blessings in this earthly life.
2. The LORD promises to send curses upon our earthly life.
3. Jesus was cursed by God for us when He was crucified on the cross.
4. God blesses us in Christ by the blood of His redemption for our forgiveness.

Wednesday – [Deuteronomy 30](#)

1. That they repent, return to the LORD their God, and obey His voice.
2. The LORD will gather and restore them and make them prosperous.
3. Not far off in heaven or far away on earth but near us in our mouth and heart
4. Not death and evil, but life and good by holding fast to Him who is our life.

Thursday – [Deuteronomy 31](#)

1. The LORD would drive out the nations. He would never leave or forsake them
2. Assemble and hear the reading of the Law so their children would fear God.
3. Joshua (Hebrew for “the LORD saves”, Jesus in Greek)
4. Bring them into the Promised Land like Jesus brings us into His kingdom.

Friday – [Deuteronomy 34](#)

1. The Land God promised to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob and their offspring.
2. God buried Moses in the valley in the land of Moab.
3. God raised Moses from the dead to appear on the Mount of Transfiguration to give testimony of Jesus and discuss His exodus. ([Luke 9:28-31](#))
4. Because the LORD spoke with him face to face and because of all the signs and wonders which the LORD sent him to do in the sight of His people.

Saturday – [Jeremiah 1](#)

1. During the reign of the last 5 kings of Judah before the exile to Babylon 587BC
2. Before God formed him in the womb and before he was born.
3. The LORD gave Jeremiah a vision of an almond branch, and he confirmed it.
4. The LORD would be with Jeremiah and make him to be a fortified city.
