Thursday – [Joshua 9](#) [LSB 651 – I Love Your Kingdom, Lord](#)

1. Instead of joining the Canaanite coalition, what did the Gibeonites do? v.1-6
2. Before making a covenant, what did the Israelites fail to do? v. 14-15
3. How did Joshua honor the oath they swore to the Gibeonites? v. 18, 26
4. How was Joshua's curse of the Gibeonite deception actually a blessing? v.22f

Friday – [Joshua 10](#) [LSB 495 – Look, Ye Saints, the Sight Is Glorious](#)

1. Why did the Canaanite kings attack Gibeon? v. 1-5
2. How did Joshua honor the covenant sworn to the Gibeonites? v. 6-8
3. How did the LORD ensure victory over the Canaanites? v. 10-15
4. How was putting their feet on the necks of their enemies like Christ? v.24-25

Saturday – [Jeremiah 15](#) [LSB 531 – Hail, Thou Once Despised Jesus](#)

1. What did king Manasseh do to bring God's judgment? v. 1-4 ([2 Chron. 33:9](#))

Answers for Daily Meditation on the Old Testament – Week 25

Sunday – [Psalm 119 vs. 1-40](#)

1. The verses of each part begin with the same letter of the Hebrew alphabet
2. Those who walk in the law of the LORD and keep His statutes and precepts.
3. By storing up God's Word in his heart, meditating on it, and speaking it.
4. He asks the LORD to teach him, give him understanding, and lead him.

Monday – [Joshua 6](#)

1. The people feared the Israelites and their God, the LORD.
2. The men of war with the priests carrying the ark of the LORD were to march around the city one time for six days and seven times on the seventh day.
3. The walls of the city fell down flat, and the Israelites captured the city.
4. Rahab and her household because by faith she helped the spies of Joshua.

Tuesday – [Joshua 7](#)

1. The LORD was not with them, and 36 soldiers died in the next battle at Ai.
2. The LORD uncovered Achan's sin and commanded he be killed.
3. He confesses his sin, "I saw . . . I coveted . . . I took."
4. Like the repentant thief on the cross, he is forgiven eternally for Christ's sake, but his crime may still bring temporal consequences on earth.

Wednesday – [Joshua 8](#)

1. Not to fear. God would give them the city, and they could take the spoils.
2. The LORD gave the city into their hand.
3. Jesus took the curse of sin for us on the tree of the cross. ([Galatians 3:13](#))
4. He wrote the Law on an altar and read it to the people between the mounts.

Thursday – [Joshua 9](#)

1. They pretended to be from a far county and pleaded for a covenant of peace.
2. They did not inquire of the LORD but trusted in their own judgment.
3. They did not kill the Gibeonites but let them live among them.
4. Because they believed in the LORD, they became workers for God's house.

Friday – [Joshua 10](#)

1. Because the Gibeonites had made peace and sided with the Israelites.
2. With the LORD's encouragement, Joshua defended the Gibeonites in battle.
3. He threw them into a panic, rained hail stones, and made the sun stand still.
4. God puts all Christ's enemies under His feet. ([Ps. 110:1](#), [1 Cor. 15:24-26](#))

Saturday – [Jeremiah 15](#)

1. He led the people to do more evil than the Canaanites before them.
2. They rejected the LORD and did not turn from their evil ways.
3. The people curse and persecute him, bringing him loneliness and pain.
4. The LORD will deliver him from the wicked and turn the people to him.
