Answers for Daily Meditation on the Old Testament – Week 26

Sunday – [Psalm 121](#)

1. Our help comes from the LORD, who made heaven and earth.
2. The LORD, who is always attentive, who neither slumbers nor sleeps.
3. The LORD keeps us both night and day from calamity.
4. The LORD keeps us forever from sin, death, and every evil through Christ.

Monday – [Joshua 11](#)

1. The Israelites bisect the land, divide & conquer, first the south then the north
2. The Israelites on foot conquered the Canaanites with their horses & chariots.
3. They receive their land inheritance and have rest from war.
4. When we leave the Church militant & enter heaven, the Church triumphant.

Tuesday – [Joshua 20](#)

1. Six cities of refuge to which a person could safely flee until trial.
2. Until the death of the high priest, then he could return to his home city.
3. Satan accuses us of our sin, and we flee to Jesus for refuge.
4. The death of our high priest, Jesus Christ, enables us to go home to heaven.

Wednesday – [Joshua 22](#)

1. They fought with their brother tribes. They could return to their inheritance.
2. They gathered for war because they thought they were rebelling against God
3. Not for sacrifice but to serve as a reminder that the east shared in the LORD.
4. Come together for discussion so each side may be heard and understood.

Thursday – [Joshua 23](#)

1. The LORD has driven out their enemies and given them the land and rest.
2. Keep the Law, keep away from false gods, love the LORD, and cling to Him.
3. The LORD will no longer drive out the nations, and the Israelites will perish.
4. Not one word of all that the good that the LORD has promised.

Friday – [Joshua 24](#)

1. They were idolaters who worshipped and served other gods.
2. Delivered them from their enemies & given them their land, cities, vineyards
3. Put away false gods, serve the LORD, and fear Him.
4. Not to forsake the LORD, but serve Him. Joshua made a covenant with them by writing it in the Book of the Law and setting up a stone monument as witness

Saturday – [Jeremiah 23](#)

1. Words of woe. The LORD will judge them for their evil deeds.
2. The LORD will gather the remnant of His flock back to His fold so they will be fruitful and multiply. He will set shepherds over them who will care for them.
3. Jesus Christ, descended from David, who reigns as king, just and righteous.
4. Jesus is righteous for us and gives us His righteousness through faith in Him.
