Answers for Daily Meditation on the Old Testament – Week 29

Sunday – [Psalm 143](#)

1. Not his own righteousness but the righteousness of the LORD.
2. He mediates and ponders on the work God’s hands have done.
3. His steadfast love, guidance, will, and deliverance from enemies.
4. By faith in Christ and His righteousness for us. ([Rom. 3:21-26](#))

Monday – [Ruth 1](#)

1. Because of the famine, they moved to Moab where her husband & sons died.
2. She told them to remain in their homeland of Moab & seek husbands there.
3. Ruth vowed that Naomi’s people would be her people & her God her God.
4. She thought the LORD had dealt bitterly to her & brought calamity upon her.

Tuesday – [Ruth 2](#)

1. “The LORD be with you!” and “The LORD bless you.”
2. Boaz put Ruth under the protection of his workers, gave her food & drink, blessed her, & instructed his workers to leave behind sheaves of grain to glean.
3. Because she trusted God, left her homeland, & cared for her mother-in-law.
4. To buy back the estate of a deceased relative who sold it because of poverty.

Wednesday – [Ruth 3](#)

1. Naomi addresses Ruth as her daughter & plays matchmaker for her & Boaz.
2. She lies at Boaz’s feet & asks him to spread his wings over her as a redeemer.
3. He blesses her and promises to redeem her if a closer relative refuses.
4. Ruth returns with a redeemer’s promise and her garment filled with barley.

Thursday – [Ruth 4](#)

1. Unlike the closer relative, Boaz would take Ruth as wife and her son as heir.
2. The LORD gives her a kinsmen redeemer and a grandson in her old age.
3. To show the lineage of king David, son of Jesse, son of Obed, son of Boaz, husband of Ruth, a Gentile brought into God’s kingdom.
4. Jesus Christ. ([Micah 5:2](#), [Luke 2:4-7](#))

Friday – [1 Samuel 1](#)

1. He loved her though the LORD had closed her womb & her rival teased her.
2. If the LORD gives her a son, she will dedicate him to the LORD all his days.
3. The LORD gives her a son whom she names Samuel, meaning “heard of God.”
4. After she weans him, Hannah brings Samuel to serve in the LORD’s house.

Saturday – [Jeremiah 28](#)

1. God will break the yoke of Nebuchadnezzar in 2 years & return the exiles.
2. If the word of the prophet comes true, then the LORD has sent him.
3. The Israelites and other nations will continue under Babylon’s yoke.
4. Hananiah dies that year just as Jeremiah, the true prophet, prophesied.
