Answers for Daily Meditation on the Old Testament – Week 33

Sunday – [Proverbs 3](#)

1. Having a heart of steadfast love and faithfulness toward God and neighbor.
2. Trust in the LORD & fear Him, and He will heal you & keep your ways straight.
3. The LORD continues to bless us with even more than we need.
4. Our LORD disciplines us out of love like a father his son in whom he delights.

Monday – [1 Samuel 17](#)

1. The Philistine champion, 9-1/2 feet tall. Single combat, loser serves winner.
2. Saul was the LORD's anointed king, armed and experienced in battle.
3. He comes in the name of the LORD and trusts in His deliverance.
4. Not with great weapons of war but with the simple weapon of a shepherd.

Tuesday – [1 Samuel 18](#)

1. He made a covenant with David & gave him his princely clothes & weapons.
2. The LORD gives David more success in battle so Saul hurls his spear at him.
3. To offer his daughter as a snare and have the Philistines kill him in battle.
4. God gives David victory in battle, and he receives honor from the people.

Wednesday – [1 Samuel 19](#)

1. He reminds Saul how David didn't sin against him but helped his kingdom.
2. Saul vows not to put David to death, and they are reconciled.
3. She warns David and helps him escape from Saul's soldiers.
4. God sends the Holy Spirit upon the men and Saul who then prophesy.

Thursday – [1 Samuel 20](#)

1. He confides in his friend Jonathan who listens to his plea and agrees to help.
2. That David show Jonathan & his descendants the steadfast love of the LORD
3. By interceding for David, Jonathan receives Saul's anger, wrath, and violence.
4. In peace & love, swearing that the LORD be between them & their offspring

Friday – [1 Samuel 24](#)

1. Kill his enemy, but David refuses to harm the LORD's anointed.
2. They show David's respect for God's anointed and trust in God's deliverance.
3. Saul repents, confesses his evil and David's innocence, and blesses him.
4. Saul knows that David will be king & asks him not to destroy his descendants.

Saturday – [Jeremiah 37](#)

1. Jehoiakim's son and descendants don't sit on the throne, but his successor Zedekiah, his servants, and people still don't listen to the word of the LORD.
2. The Babylonians (Chaldeans) will return, conquer, and burn Jerusalem.
3. They accuse him of deserting to the Babylonians, beat him, & imprison him.
4. Jeremiah tells him that he will be delivered into the hands of the king of Babylon. Zedekiah releases Jeremiah from prison to the court of the guard.
