Answers for Daily Meditation on the Old Testament – Week 35

Sunday – [Proverbs 6](#)

1. Motivated from within by the Gospel, we labor in our vocation for others.
2. Lying tongue, shedding innocent blood, making wicked plans, sowing discord
3. The commandments and teaching of a godly father and mother.
4. Revenge from jealous spouses, self-destruction, dishonor, and disgrace.

Monday – [2 Samuel 5](#)

1. As shepherd of the LORD's people, to lead the army of Israel in battle.
2. He enters through the water shaft, and it becomes the capital, city of David.
3. He first inquired of the LORD whether he should do so.
4. The LORD of hosts (army) went before David and struck down his enemies.

Tuesday – [2 Samuel 6](#)

1. By bringing the ark of the covenant to the Tabernacle in Jerusalem.
2. Instead of an ox cart, the ark was to be carried only by Levites using poles.
3. God blesses the house of Obed-edom where the ark resides.
4. Per God's instructions with the Levites bearing it and the proper offerings.

Wednesday – [2 Samuel 7](#)

1. To build a permanent house for the LORD instead of a tent/tabernacle.
2. The LORD will build a house for David by raising up offspring to rule after him
3. David's son Solomon will build the Temple in Jerusalem.
4. David's descendant Jesus Christ will rule at the right hand of God forever.

Thursday – [2 Samuel 11](#)

1. Leading the Israelite army in battle.
2. He lusts, covets another man's wife, and commits adultery with Bathsheba.
3. He tries to cover up his sin, then has Uriah killed in battle, then takes his wife.
4. The LORD sees David's sin and is displeased.

Friday – [2 Samuel 12](#)

1. He tells a parallel story of two men which makes David convict himself.
2. David confesses that he has sinned against the LORD & Nathan absolves him.
3. War in his family, his son would die, & another would publicly defile his wives
4. David knows that his son's spirit is in heaven and that when he dies, he will go to him. God also blesses David and Bathsheba with another son, Solomon.

Saturday – [Jeremiah 39](#)

1. After 1-1/2 years of siege, Babylon breaches Jerusalem and conquers it.
2. The king of Babylon slaughtered his sons in his sight then put out his eyes.
3. They are taken into exile to Babylon except for some of the poor people.
4. The king of Babylon commands that Jeremiah be treated well. The LORD protects Jeremiah's life from his enemies, and he remains in Judah.
