## Answers for Daily Meditation on the Old Testament – Week 38

### Sunday – [Proverbs 11](#)

1. Christ, the righteous, who redeemed me not with gold but with His blood.
2. The fool belittles his neighbor and reveals secrets, but the wise stays silent.
3. She is like a gold ring in a pig's snout.
4. He captures souls of believers & gives them life through the fruit of His cross.

### Monday – [1 Kings 3](#)

1. Ask what I shall give you.
2. Not riches or long life but wisdom to govern God's people.
3. Not only great wisdom in governing but also riches and long life.
4. He discerned human nature and settled the dispute of 2 women over a child.

### Tuesday – [1 Kings 5](#)

1. David was busy in warfare, and God said that his son would build the temple.
2. He makes a treaty and establishes trade with a peaceful neighbor, Hiram.
3. 3,300 officers overseeing 180,000 laborers – burden-bearers & stonecutters.
4. Great dressed stones for the foundation and cedars of Lebanon for timber.

### Wednesday – [1 Kings 6](#)

1. 90' long, 30' wide, 45' high with portico & side chambers on the perimeter
2. That God would dwell among the people of Israel and not forsake them.
3. With engravings of cherubim, palm trees, and open flowers. All the inner walls, floors, doors, and images were overlaid with gold.
4. Seven years from laying the foundation to finishing the details.

### Thursday – [1 Kings 8](#)

1. A cloud, which was the glory of the LORD, filled the house of the LORD.
2. That David's son would build a house for the LORD & the ark of the covenant.
3. That God would hear their prayer, forgive them, and return them to the land.
4. That all the peoples of the earth may know that the LORD is God.

### Friday – [1 Kings 9](#)

1. God would establish his royal throne over Israel forever.
2. God would cut off Israel from the land and the temple would become a ruin.
3. All the remaining peoples as slaves, but the Israelites as officials and soldiers.
4. 420 talents or 31,500 pounds or nearly 16 tons.

### Saturday – [Ezekiel 2](#)

1. The Holy Spirit entered into him and set him on his feet.
2. To speak the word of the LORD to a rebellious people.
3. Not to be afraid of them, their words, or looks but speak God's word to them.
4. A scroll of a book with words of lamentation, mourning, and woe.
