Answers for Daily Meditation on the Old Testament – Week 39

Sunday – [Proverbs 15](#)

1. With right content (knowledge) and also a right manner (soft answer).
2. His omniscience and omnipresence ensure justice for the good and the evil.
3. The offerings of the wicked lack faith but the upright have faith in Christ.
4. When one has the fear and love of the Lord instead of trouble and hate.

Monday – [1 Kings 10](#)

1. The queen of Sheba (S.W. Arabia) heard of his fame & questioned his wisdom
2. The LORD God who set him on the throne to be king of Israel.
3. He excelled all other kings in wisdom & the whole earth sought to hear him.
4. He received 25 tons of gold a year, he had a great throne of ivory and gold, he had a fleet of trading ships, and he had 1400 chariots and 12,000 horsemen.

Tuesday – [1 Kings 11](#)

1. To turn away from the LORD, build high places, and worship foreign gods
2. God will give the kingdom to Solomon's servant, but his son will rule 1 tribe.
3. God raises up Hadad, Rezon, and Jeroboam as adversaries against Solomon.
4. After Solomon's death, Jeroboam will rule over the ten northern tribes.

Wednesday – [1 Kings 12](#)

1. To be a servant to the people and deal kindly with their request for relief.
2. To the young men who advise him to increase the burden upon the people.
3. By God's design, the 10 northern tribes rebelled & made Jeroboam their king.
4. He sets up 2 high places with a golden calf & enlists priests who aren't Levites

Thursday – [1 Kings 13](#)

1. King Josiah would sacrifice the priests on their pagan altar. [2 Kings 23:15-16](#)
2. The altar was torn down and Jeroboam's outstretched hand dried up.
3. The prophet was not to have fellowship with Jeroboam by eating in his house
4. Because the prophet disobeyed God, he was killed by a lion and was buried.

Friday – [1 Kings 14](#)

1. God will cut off every male from the line of Jeroboam & remove the kingship.
2. God will remove them from their land & scatter them beyond the Euphrates.
3. They began foreign worship at high places & performed their abominations.
4. Shishak, king of Egypt, came and carried off all the treasures of the temple.

Saturday – [Ezekiel 3](#)

1. The Law and its condemnation are bitter, but the Gospel of salvation is sweet
2. The Holy Spirit lifts Ezekiel up to preach to the rebellious exiles of Israel.
3. The wicked person would die for his sins, but his blood would be on Ezekiel.
4. The righteous person would live, and so would Ezekiel.
