Answers for Daily Meditation on the Old Testament – Week 40

Sunday – [Proverbs 23](#)

1. You will see it sprout wings and fly away like an eagle toward heaven.
2. You will save his soul from death and give him wisdom and truth.
3. You will be wise, true, and understanding, and your parents will rejoice.
4. You will have woes, sorrow, strife, hallucinations, and lack of feeling.

Monday – [1 Kings 17](#)

1. The LORD would withhold rain from the land until Elijah prayed for it.
2. He drank from the brook and the ravens brought him bread and meat.
3. The jar of flour and jug of oil of the widow would not run out until it rained.
4. Elijah prayed to the LORD, and God raised the son from the dead.

Tuesday – [1 Kings 18](#)

1. The people refused and did not answer a word.
2. No one answered; no one paid attention.
3. The LORD sent fire from heaven to burn up the sacrifice, and the people fell on their faces and confessed, “The LORD, he is God.”
4. The heavens grew black with clouds and wind, and there was a great rain.

Wednesday – [1 Kings 19](#)

1. He despaired, fled into the wilderness, and asked the LORD to take his life.
2. The angel of the LORD gave him heavenly bread and water for food & drink.
3. God told Elijah that 7,000 still believed in the LORD and that he should anoint Jehu as the new king of Israel and Elisha to be prophet after him.
4. He leaves his farming life behind by sacrificing his oxen and follows Elijah.

Thursday – [1 Kings 21](#)

1. Ahab offered Naboth a better vineyard for it or to buy it at a good price.
2. Ahab pouted, withdrew to his bedroom, and refused to eat.
3. Queen Jezebel had Naboth falsely accused and stoned for blasphemy.
4. Ahab repented and humbled himself, so the LORD delayed his disaster.

Friday – [1 Kings 22](#)

1. They should fight against Syria, retake Ramoth-gilead, and be victorious.
2. He prophesied defeat of the armies of Israel & Judah and the death of Ahab.
3. Ahab was slain, and dogs licked up his blood where Naboth had been killed.
4. He did what was right in the eyes of God, but the people remained idolatrous.

Saturday – [Ezekiel 18](#)

1. The son shall not suffer for the sins of the father and vice-versa.
2. The one who turns from righteousness and sins.
3. The one who repents, turns from sin and trusts in Christ’s righteousness.
4. God takes no pleasure in the death of the wicked but that he repent and live.
