1. Why did Jesus withdraw into Galilee, north of Judea? v. 12

4. What else accompanied Jesus' preaching and teaching the Gospel? v. 23-25

4. Besides doing no wrong, what should we do to be perfect like God? v.43-48

Thursday – [Matthew 6:1-15](#) [LSB 766 – Our Father, Who from Heaven Above](#)

1. How are we to give to the needy? v. 1-4
2. How are we to pray individually? v. 5-6
3. How are we to pray corporately? v. 9-13
4. What do we show when we do not forgive others? v. 14-15

1. Why do we take times to fast? v. 16-18
2. How do we lay up treasure in heaven? v. 19-24
3. If God feeds the birds and clothes the flowers, what do we know? v. 25-32
4. What are we to seek first? v. 33

Saturday – [Romans 3](#) [LSB 794 – The Lord, My God, Be Praised](#)

1. Does the faithlessness of Christians nullify God's faithfulness? v. 1-6
2. Why can the works of the Law not justify anyone before God? v. 9-20
3. What is the righteousness of God which the Prophets testified of? v. 21-22
4. Though all have sinned, how are we justified before God? v. 23-28

Answers for Daily Meditation on the New Testament – Week 2

Sunday – [Romans 2](#)

1. We are judging and condemning ourselves because we do the same things.
2. Jew or Gentile, having knowledge or ignorance, will perish as sinners.
3. God writes the Law on their hearts in their moral conscience.
4. When they see Christian hypocrites who preach one thing & do the opposite.

Monday – [Matthew 4:12-25](#)

1. After Herod arrested John, Jesus departed to begin His ministry unhindered.
2. The people in Galilee saw a great light when they saw & heard Jesus preach.
3. Not religious scholars, but humble fishermen who would be fishers of men.
4. His works of mercy in healing diseases & paralysis & casting out demons.

Tuesday – [Matthew 5:1-20](#)

1. Not ethical demands but blessings believers will have in the kingdom of God.
2. Because Christ has won salvation and prepares a place for them in heaven.
3. People see their good works and glorify the Father in heaven.
4. Not to abolish the Law or say that "sin is okay," but to fulfill the Law and the Prophets by keeping the Law for us and dying for our sins.

Wednesday – [Matthew 5:21-48](#)

1. By angry thoughts or words and by lusting or divorce.
2. If he has something against us, we should first be reconciled to our brother.
3. Not to retaliate but to give to those in need.
4. Love our enemies and pray for those who persecute us.

Thursday – [Matthew 6:1-15](#)

1. Not with fanfare for the praise of men, but in secret for the praise of God.
2. Not publicly to gain attention from men, but privately where God hears us.
3. Our Father . . . give us . . . forgive us . . . lead us . . . deliver us.
4. That we do not believe that God forgives us.

Friday – [Matthew 6:16-34](#)

1. Not to show off, but to discipline the body, repent, pray, and meditate.
2. By using our money to bring people (treasure) into the kingdom of heaven.
3. That God will certainly feed and clothe us, His highest creation.
4. The kingdom of God and His righteousness, and God will supply the rest.

Saturday – [Romans 3](#)

1. No! Our unrighteousness shows our need for God's righteousness in Christ.
2. Because no one is righteous, all have turned from God, no one does good.
3. The righteousness of Christ which we receive through faith in Him.
4. We are justified by God's grace through Christ's redemption and faith in Him.
