### Sunday – [Romans 6](#)    [LSB 604 – I Bind unto Myself Today](#)

1. Are we to deliberately keep on sinning since God forgives us anyway? v. 1-4
2. How are we united with Christ's death and resurrection? v. 5-11
3. When Christ set us free from slaves of sin, what did He free us to be? v.15-22
4. What are our due wages from sinning, and what is God's free gift? v. 23

### Monday – [Matthew 9:18-38](#)    [LSB 826 – Hark, the Voice of Jesus Crying](#)

1. What do both the ruler and sick woman believe about Jesus? v. 18-26
2. What was often a prerequisite for receiving Jesus' healing/blessing? v. 27-31
3. What did the Pharisees attribute Jesus' power to cast out demons? v. 32-34
4. What does Jesus tell his disciples and us to pray for? v. 35-38

### Tuesday – [Matthew 10:1-25](#)    [LSB 856 – O Christ, Who Called the Twelve](#)

1. As His apostles (one who is sent), what did Jesus send the 12 to do? v. 1-8
2. How were the 12 apostles to live without receiving pay? v. 8-13
3. What would happen to those who did not receive or listen to them? v.14-15
4. As disciples of Jesus, what could the apostles expect to encounter? v. 16-25

### Wednesday – [Matt. 10:26-42](#)    [LSB 688 – “Come, Follow Me,” the Savior Spake](#)

1. Whom are we not to fear, and whom are we to fear? v. 26-28
2. If God takes care of sparrows, who else will He be sure to care for? v. 29-31
3. Jesus came to bring peace with God but not peace between whom? v. 34-39
4. Who is a person receiving by receiving a disciple & what is his reward? v. 40f

### Thursday – [Matthew 11:1-19](#)    [LSB 394 – Songs of Thankfulness and Praise](#)

1. Why would John the Baptist question whether Jesus was the Messiah? v.2-3
2. Instead of just saying, “Yes,” how does Jesus prove His Messiahship? v. 4-6
3. Whom did Jesus testify that John was? v. 13-14 ([Malachi 4:5-6](#))
4. To what does Jesus compare those who criticized Jesus and John? v. 16-19

### Friday – [Matthew 11:20-30](#)    [LSB 684 – Come unto Me, Ye Weary](#)

1. Why did Jesus denounce the cities where He did His mighty works? v. 20
2. Why would the Jewish cities be judged harsher than pagan cities? v. 21-24
3. What was the gracious will of God the Father? v. 25-28
4. What does Jesus invite those burdened by sin to do and receive? v. 28-30

### Saturday – [Romans 7](#)    [LSB 698 – May We Thy Precepts, Lord Fulfill](#)

1. For how long is a person bound to his spouse until he freely marries another?
2. How long are we bound to the Law and its consequences for sinning? v. 1-6
3. The Law is good, but what does the Law show us? v. 7-12
4. Saint Paul struggles still being a sinner, but where is his deliverance? v.21-25

## Answers for Daily Meditation on the New Testament – Week 4

### Sunday – [Romans 6](#)

1. No! Christ died and rose again so that we might die to self & rise to new life.
2. In baptism our old nature is crucified & killed, & our new nature rises to live.
3. Slaves of God and righteousness so that we might live a sanctified life.
4. The wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus.

### Monday – [Matthew 9:18-38](#)

1. That Jesus can raise his dead daughter and heal the woman of her disease.
2. Faith in Jesus that He can do what a believer asks.
3. They blasphemed Jesus, saying He cast out demons by the power of the devil.
4. Pray to the Lord of the harvest to send out church workers into His field.

### Tuesday – [Matthew 10:1-25](#)

1. With Christ's authority, proclaim God's kingdom in the hearts of men, heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse lepers, and cast out demons.
2. Those who received them and heard their message would provide for them.
3. They would be judged and punished on Judgment Day. ([Matthew 25:41-46](#))
4. Hatred and persecution from which it was okay to flee to the next town.

### Wednesday – [Matt. 10:26-42](#)

1. Not men who can kill the body, but God who can destroy body & soul in hell.
2. Human beings, especially His disciples, even down to the hairs of their head.
3. Believers and unbelievers, even if they live in the same household.
4. Jesus and God the Father. His reward is heaven. ([Matthew 25:31-40](#))

### Thursday – [Matthew 11:1-19](#)

1. Imprisoned by Herod, John didn't see Jesus judging the wicked (2<sup>nd</sup> coming).
2. By fulfilling the prophecy of the Messiah's mercy ([Isaiah 61:1](#)) (1<sup>st</sup> coming).
3. The forerunner of the Christ who preached repentance in the spirit of Elijah.
4. Like children who complained Jesus and John didn't do what they wanted.

### Friday – [Matthew 11:20-30](#)

1. Because they did not repent at His preaching, turn from sin, & believe in Him.
2. After seeing His miracles, pagan cities would have repented but they did not.
3. To reveal His Son & His salvation to the lowly but hide them from the mighty.
4. Come to Jesus, put their burdens on Him, and receive His rest.

### Saturday – [Romans 7](#)

1. Until his spouse dies, then he may marry another without being an adulterer.
2. Til our old man dies, then we are free from the Law & freely belong to Christ.
3. The Law shows us our sin which kills us.
4. Not in himself but in Jesus Christ our Lord.
