1. Why does Jesus at first refuse the prayer of the Canaanite woman? v. 21-26

3. What is similar between the accounts of Jesus feeding 5,000 and 4,000?
4. What is different from the account of Jesus feeding 5,000 men plus? v.32-39

1. What is the only sign Jesus will give an adulterous & evil generation? v. 1-4
2. What did Jesus mean by saying, “Beware of the leaven of the Pharisees?” v.12
3. Whom did Peter confess that Jesus is? v. 13-16
4. Upon what will Christ build His Church which hell cannot overcome? v.17-19

Friday – [Matthew 16:21-28](#) [LSB 685 – Let Us Ever Walk with Jesus](#)

1. What does Jesus foretell to His disciples based upon the prophets? v. 21
2. After Peter’s rebuke that this won’t happen, what does Jesus say? v. 22-23
3. What is the cost and result of following Jesus? v. 24-26
4. How would some in Jesus’ day see the coming of His kingdom? v. 28

Saturday – [Romans 11](#) [LSB 756 – God Moves in a Mysterious Way](#)

1. Has God rejected the Jewish people? v. 1-6
2. If God can graft in the wild branches of the Gentiles, what else can He do? v.24
3. How are both Jews and Gentiles, hardened enemies of God, saved? v. 25-32
4. Why can’t we always understand God and His way of salvation? v. 33-36

Answers for Daily Meditation on the New Testament – Week 6

Sunday – [Romans 10](#)

1. They sought their own righteousness by keeping the Law & failed repeatedly.
2. Christ kept the Law for us and gives us His righteousness through faith in Him
3. We confess Jesus is LORD (God) and believe God raised Him from the dead.
4. By hearing the message of the Gospel preached by those God sends.

Monday – [Matthew 14:22-36](#)

1. He sent His disciples across the lake & departed to a mountain to pray alone.
2. They think Jesus is a ghost walking on the water, but Jesus calms them.
3. He doesn’t try to swim, but cries out in faith, “Lord, save me!”
4. They worshipped Jesus and confessed Him as the Son of God.

Tuesday – [Matthew 15:1-20](#)

1. Breaking their manmade traditions about handwashing.
2. Breaking God’s Commandments and keeping and teaching their traditions.
3. They are weeds that God will uproot and blind guides who will fall into a pit.
4. The sinful heart of man.

Wednesday – [Matthew 15:21-39](#)

1. Jesus is testing her faith in Him, not as a miracle worker but as her Lord.
2. The woman confesses her unworthiness, and Jesus praises her faith in Him.
3. Jesus’ compassion, the disciples lack of faith, Jesus giving thanks and multiplying bread and fish, the disciples distributing and taking up a remainder.
4. Crowds hadn’t eaten in three days, 7 loaves, 7 baskets left over, & 4,000 men

Thursday – [Matthew 16:1-20](#)

1. The sign of Jonah: Jesus will be 3 days in the belly of the earth before rising.
2. Beware of the teaching of the Pharisees and Sadducees.
3. Not just a man or prophet, but the Christ, the Son of the living God.
4. Not upon Peter, but upon the confession of Peter that Jesus is the Christ and the forgiveness of sins proclaimed in His name.

Friday – [Matthew 16:21-28](#)

1. That He must go to Jerusalem, suffer many things, be killed, & rise in 3 days.
2. Get behind me, Satan! You’re a hindrance to me, thinking the things of man.
3. Denying the things of the world and taking up a cross of suffering in this life.
4. They would see Jesus’ resurrection, Pentecost, and the growth of His Church.

Saturday – [Romans 11](#)

1. No, as in Jesus’ day many of God’s elect among the Jews come to faith in Him
2. God can graft into His Church the broken off but natural branches of the Jews
3. By God’s choosing, His calling by the Gospel, and His mercy in Christ.
4. As humans, we can’t understand the depth of God’s wisdom & knowledge.
