Answers for Daily Meditation on the New Testament – Week 7

Sunday – [Romans 12](#)

1. By the renewal of our mind, we offer a holy life which does God's will.
2. Christ is our head & we are the parts of His body with different gifts to use.
3. Give them honor, pray for them, give to their needs, show them hospitality.
4. Bless those who persecute us, don't avenge but give them food and drink.

Monday – [Matthew 17:1-13](#)

1. His face shone like the sun, and his clothes became as white as light.
2. Moses & Elijah, representing the Law & the prophets, who testified to Jesus.
3. God the Father testified Jesus is His beloved Son. We are to listen to Him.
4. John the Baptist ([Malachi 4:5-6](#))

Tuesday – [Matthew 17:14-27](#)

1. He prays for Jesus to have mercy on his son, and Jesus casts out the demon.
2. They didn't have faith in Jesus and pray to Him who can move mountains.
3. Jesus foretold His death at the hands of men, and His resurrection in 3 days.
4. He honors the Law and miraculously provides the tax from a fish's mouth.

Wednesday – [Matthew 18:1-14](#)

1. A child comes humbly, with nothing to offer God but childlike trust.
2. Belief and faith in Jesus and therefore entrance into the kingdom of God.
3. A surgery and change of the heart and spirit where the true trouble lies.
4. Our guardian angels, the Lord our shepherd, and the angels in heaven.

Thursday – [Matthew 18:15-35](#)

1. Tell him his fault. If he repents, forgive him. If not, consult with 1 or 2 other brothers. If he refuses to listen, bring it to the Church for judgment.
2. Wherever 2 or 3 gather in His name to bind or forgive sins.
3. He didn't show gratitude for the king's mercy by forgiving his fellow servant.
4. We show that we do not truly believe that God forgives us.

Friday – [Matthew 19:1-15](#)

1. Jesus cites God's institution of marriage. What God joins, man isn't to part.
2. When 1 spouse breaks the marriage oath & commits adultery with another.
3. No. The choice to remain single and ability to remain chaste is a gift of God.
4. Jesus blesses the children who themselves are a blessing of marriage.

Saturday – [Romans 13](#)

1. Because God instituted government to be His servant for justice. ([Gen. 9:6](#))
2. Not because the estate of government which God instituted is bad, but because evil men hold the office.
3. By loving one another as ourselves.
4. By putting on the righteousness of Jesus Christ in baptism & by faith in Him.
