## Answers for Daily Meditation on the New Testament – Week 10

### Sunday – [1 Corinthians 2](#)

1. Not with lofty speech but a proclamation of Jesus Christ and Him crucified.
2. Not persuasive words & man's wisdom but the Holy Spirit and power of God.
3. What God has prepared for those who love him.
4. The natural man cannot, but the Holy Spirit gives us understanding.

### Monday – [Matthew 25:1-30](#)

1. They didn't have spare oil for their lamps & weren't ready for the bridegroom
2. By repenting and remaining in the faith.
3. He believed his master to be a hard man so he was afraid to use the talent.
4. They believed him to be forgiving so they weren't afraid to use the talents.

### Tuesday – [Matthew 25:31-46](#)

1. He will separate the believers from the unbelievers.
2. Jesus' apostles/disciples/pastors/missionaries who preached the Gospel.
3. Because they received and welcomed the above and believed their message.
4. Because they didn't receive & welcome the above & doubted their message.

### Wednesday – [Matthew 26:1-35](#)

1. Because Judas gave them an opportunity to betray Jesus secretly.
2. They saw her action as a waste, but she anointed Jesus to prepare His burial.
3. With the bread and wine, His body and blood for the forgiveness of sins.
4. During His passion, they will all fall away, and Peter will deny Him 3 times.

### Thursday – [Matthew 26:36-75](#)

1. If possible, remove the cup of His wrath, but let His will be done.
2. By calling on 12 legions (72,000) angels, but He must fulfill the Scriptures.
3. Jesus confessed He was the Son of God so He was charged with blasphemy.
4. He remembered Jesus' words and went outside and wept bitterly.

### Friday – [Matthew 27:1-31](#)

1. Because the chief priests would not absolve him, Judas despaired.
2. They choose to release a notorious prisoner & shout for Jesus to be crucified.
3. The mob of Temple Jews take the blame on themselves and their children.
4. He was scrouged, stripped, mocked, struck, spit on, & crowned with thorns.

### Saturday – [1 Corinthians 3](#)

1. God germinates & provides the miraculous growth of faith in a Christian.
2. Paul lays the foundation of Jesus Christ, the Church's one foundation.
3. The Holy Spirit dwells in us.
4. The Church should benefit from all of God's servants who are under Christ.
