1. What was Jesus' final temptation on the cross? v. 39-44

4. Why would it have been impossible for anyone to steal Jesus' body? v.62-66

4. How are the disciples to make more disciples? v. 19-20

1. What did John the Baptist proclaim and preach? v. 4-8
2. How were all three persons of the Trinity present at Jesus' baptism? v. 9-11
3. What was the gist of Jesus' preaching? v. 14-15
4. Who were the first disciples Jesus called to follow Him? v. 16-20

1. How did Jesus astonish the people in the synagogue in Capernaum? v. 21-28
2. How else did Jesus show that His word had authority? v. 29-34
3. What was an early morning habit of Jesus & what did he come to do? v.35-39
4. Why did Jesus often command those He healed not to speak of it? v. 43-45

## Answers for Daily Meditation on the New Testament – Week 11

### Sunday – [1 Corinthians 4](#)

1. As a steward of the mysteries of God, that is the Gospel and the Sacraments.
2. Not ourselves or any human court but only the Lord Jesus on the Last Day.
3. As last, sentenced to death, a spectacle, a fool, weak, in disrepute, poor
4. A pastor, teacher, evangelists, mom or dad, or other disciple of Christ.

### Monday – [Matthew 27:32-66](#)

1. To prove He was the Son of God by coming down from the cross.
2. The temple curtain split, earthquake, tombs opened, saints raised from dead
3. In the new tomb of a rich man, Joseph of Arimathea, a disciple of Jesus.
4. The Jewish religious rulers posted a Temple guard of soldiers at the tomb.

### Tuesday – [Matthew 28:1-10](#)

1. The same women who saw where Jesus was buried: Mary Magdalene & Mary
2. He rolled back the tombstone. The guards trembled, becoming like dead men
3. Jesus is risen. Go and tell His disciples. They will see Him in Galilee.
4. Jesus greeted them. They took hold of His feet and worshipped Him.

### Wednesday – [Matthew 28:11-20](#)

1. That they fell asleep on their watch, and the disciples came & stole the body.
2. On a mount in Galilee. Though the disciples worshipped Him, some doubted.
3. By the authority of Jesus who was given authority from God the Father.
4. By baptizing in the name of the Trinity and by teaching all Jesus taught.

### Thursday – [Mark 1:1-20](#)

1. A baptism of repentance for forgiveness and the coming Messiah.
2. The Holy Spirit anointed the Son of God as God the Father spoke from heaven
3. The time is fulfilled, the kingdom of God is near; repent & believe the Gospel
4. Not religious teachers, but common fishermen: Simon, Andrew, James, John

### Friday – [Mark 1:21-45](#)

1. He taught with authority and His word even drove out demons.
2. By His word & touch, Jesus healed many, cast out demons & silenced them.
3. He prayed alone. Though He healed many, His primary duty in His office of prophet was to preach.
4. Jesus wanted the cleansed leper to follow the ceremonial law to prove he was clean, but Jesus also didn't want His miracles to overshadow His preaching.

### Saturday – [1 Corinthians 5](#)

1. Incest, a man has his father's wife. He should be removed from the church.
2. To condemn sin in a brother so that he may repent and be saved.
3. He is slain & His blood is smeared on the cross so that death passes over us.
4. Not those outside the church but unrepentant sinners in the church.
