Answers for Daily Meditation on the New Testament – Week 12

Sunday – [1 Corinthians 6](#)

1. Let another Christian mediate our grievance, or simply suffer the wrong.
2. All former, unrepentant sinners, but God has sanctified us in baptism & justified us in Christ by faith given by the Holy Spirit.
3. Not for sexual immorality but for the Lord's service as a member of His body.
4. Christ bought us with His blood & the Holy Spirit dwells in us for God's glory.

Monday – [Mark 2:1-17](#)

1. They trusted Jesus & removed the roof to bring their friend for Jesus to heal.
2. Jesus first heals the man's spirit by forgiving his sins.
3. Jesus does the harder task by healing the man's body of paralysis.
4. Not the self-righteous but sinners who are sick.

Tuesday – [Mark 2:18-28](#)

1. They don't fast because Jesus is with them, but they will when Jesus dies.
2. The Gospel message destroys the old traditions of fasting & table fellowship.
3. Not to burden men with rules but for their rest and worship of the LORD.
4. As the living Word of God, Jesus created the Sabbath & has authority over it.

Wednesday – [Mark 3:1-21](#)

1. Against their Sabbath rules, Jesus heals a man and does good on the Sabbath.
2. We are not to accept the testimony of lying demons but of God's servants.
3. To preach the Gospel and cast out Satan's minions like He did.
4. They said Jesus was out of His mind.

Thursday – [Mark 3:22-35](#)

1. They said Jesus was possessed by Satan and cast out demons by His power.
2. If by Satan's power, Jesus cast out demons, then Satan was fighting against himself & his kingdom would fall. Jesus is binding Satan & plundering his house.
3. They continually denied Jesus when presented with His words and miracles.
4. Not His family who said He lost His mind but whoever does the will of God.

Friday – [Mark 4:1-20](#)

1. Those who hear the word, but Satan immediately takes it from their hearts.
2. Those who receive the word with joy but fall away when persecution comes.
3. Those who hear the word, but the temptations of the world choke the word.
4. Those who hear the word, receive it, & bear good fruit by making disciples.

Saturday – [1 Corinthians 7](#)

1. So that men and women will not be tempted to sin by fornication or adultery.
2. When the unbelieving spouse deserts the believing spouse.
3. Not to leave their vocation but remain where God has called them.
4. Freedom from family duties to dedicate oneself to solely serving the Lord.
