Answers for Daily Meditation on the New Testament – Week 13

Sunday – [1 Corinthians 8](#)

1. Personal knowledge might puff one up with pride, but love builds others up.
2. In reality, idols don't exist as gods because there is only one God.
3. He knows the idol/god is not real so he can eat in good conscience.
4. The brother may be tempted to eat against conscience or return to idolatry.

Monday – [Mark 4:21-41](#)

1. Hiding the message of the Gospel instead of proclaiming it to others.
2. We plant God's word and harvest souls but we know not how it works.
3. It starts small in men's hearts but grows to become the largest religion of all.
4. He must be God who created the heavens and earth, wind and sea.

Tuesday – [Mark 5:1-20](#)

1. He was possessed by a legion of demons, out of control and cutting himself.
2. That Jesus not torment them but let them enter the herd of pigs.
3. The herd rushed into the sea & drowned, & the people asked Jesus to leave.
4. Go home & tell what the Lord has done for you & how He had mercy on you.

Wednesday – [Mark 5:21-43](#)

1. If she just touches Jesus' garment, she will be made well.
2. Her faith in Jesus received His healing, and she may depart in peace.
3. Do not fear, only believe.
4. Jesus can raise the dead as easily as rousing one from sleep.

Thursday – [Mark 6:1-29](#)

1. He could do only a few miracles because of their unbelief.
2. When they left, shake off the dust of their feet as a testimony against them.
3. Because he had taken his brother Philip's wife, Herodias, and married her.
4. Because of his foolish oath before his guests and Herodias' grudge.

Friday – [Mark 6:30-56](#)

1. Not by their own means but because Jesus gives it through them.
2. Jesus gives His body and blood in the bread and wine for pastors to distribute
3. Because they saw him miraculously walking on the water.
4. He said "Take heart; it is I. Do not be afraid." Then He calmed the sea.

Saturday – [1 Corinthians 9](#)

1. He has a right to make a living from the Gospel & bring along a believing wife.
2. As they share in the crop, he should also reap material things from his sowing
3. Those who proclaim the Gospel should get their living by the Gospel.
4. He disciplines mind & spirit not to receive a perishable prize but imperishable
