## Answers for Daily Meditation on the New Testament – Week 14

### Sunday – [1 Corinthians 10](#)

1. The Son of God (Exodus 17:1-7) who was struck and who gave forth His lifegiving blood on the cross for us to drink in Holy Communion.
2. He won't allow temptations beyond our ability but provide a way of escape.
3. A participation or communion with the body and blood of Christ.
4. We should not use it to give offense to our neighbor but for his good.

### Monday – [Mark 7:1-23](#)

1. By keeping their manmade traditions but not the Commandments of God.
2. Showing off their piety with special offerings but not caring for their parents.
3. Not what goes into his mouth but the evil that comes out of his heart.
4. Gentiles will not have to observe Jewish dietary laws that kept them separate

### Tuesday – [Mark 7:24-37](#)

1. Jesus implies that He first came to feed the Jews not Gentile dogs.
2. Because of the woman's humility and faith in Jesus.
3. So the man will realize that Jesus is the one healing him.
4. They proclaimed His mighty deed and praised Him.

### Wednesday – [Mark 8:1-21](#)

1. Because they'd been with Him 3 days with no food & would faint going home
2. He multiplies 7 loaves to feed and satisfy all of them with 7 baskets remaining
3. Give them a sign from heaven, but because of their unbelief, Jesus refuses.
4. The sin of unbelief even in the presence of Jesus and His miracles.

### Thursday – [Mark 8:22-38](#)

1. He not only restored the blind man's sight but gave him clear, natural vision.
2. John the Baptist, Elijah, or a prophet but Peter confessed Jesus as the Christ.
3. Peter rebuked Jesus for speaking this way.
4. Jesus rebuked Peter & said that any who follow Him must also bear his cross.

### Friday – [Mark 9:1-29](#)

1. By His glory and His Father's words from heaven that He is the Son of God.
2. About Jesus rising from the dead & John the Baptist was the Elijah to come.
3. Because of belief in Jesus who makes all things possible.
4. They attempted by their own strength instead of praying to Jesus.

### Saturday – [1 Corinthians 11](#)

1. God the Father who is over Christ who is over man who is over wife.
2. The order of creation: the woman was created from man and for man.
3. We gather regularly at the altar in a common confession of faith.
4. To ensure unworthy communicants (unbelieving, unrepentant, not knowing what they are receiving) do not sin and bring God's judgment on themselves.
