Answers for Daily Meditation on the New Testament – Week 16

Sunday – [1 Corinthians 14](#)

1. The one speaking in tongues edifies himself; prophecy edifies the church.
2. No one understands the tongue speaking, but all understand the prophecy.
3. There should be order in the service to build up the church.
4. She is not to speak by preaching because God gives that office to men.

Monday – [Mark 12:1-27](#)

1. God the Father, prophets, God the Son, the Jewish leaders, and the Church.
2. "Yes" to taxes would anger the people; "No" to taxes would be treason.
3. By distinguishing the kingdom of the left & right. A Christian renders to both
4. There is no human marriage in heaven, & the patriarchs now live in heaven.

Tuesday – [Mark 12:28-44](#)

1. Love God with all your heart and love your neighbor as yourself.
2. Only if David's offspring would also be divine.
3. They know God's Word but use their office hypocritically for their honor.
4. She gave all she had and trusted God to provide for her daily bread.

Wednesday – [Mark 13](#)

1. The destruction of Jerusalem and the Temple in 70 A.D. by the Romans.
2. False christs, wars, famines, persecution, and desecration of the Temple.
3. With great power He will send His angels (messengers) to gather His Church.
4. The Last Day at Jesus second coming; therefore, we must stay in the faith.

Thursday – [Mark 14:1-31](#)

1. Her act of love is recorded in 3 of the Gospels and proclaimed to the world.
2. Because Judas came forward with an opportunity to betray Jesus alone.
3. They followed a man carrying a jar of water & his master provided a room.
4. One would betray Him, one would deny Him thrice, and all would fall away.

Friday – [Mark 14:32-72](#)

1. That the Father would remove His cup of wrath, but that God's will be done.
2. He was betrayed by a friend with a kiss. They could have easily arrested him by day in the Temple but they feared the people and not His disciples who fled.
3. That Jesus said He was the Christ the Son of God.
4. Under pressure from a servant girl and bystanders, he denies Jesus 3 times.

Saturday – [1 Corinthians 15](#)

1. Christ died for sin, was raised on the 3rd day, and appeared alive to hundreds.
2. In Adam all die, but in Christ all shall be made alive.
3. perishable vs. imperishable, dishonor vs. glory, weakness vs. power, image of man vs. image of God.
4. We'll be raised imperishable & Death will be swallowed up by Christ's victory
