1. To whom did Jesus first appear and what did she do? v. 9-10

4. After giving the Great Commission, where did Jesus go? v. 19

Answers for Daily Meditation on the New Testament – Week 17

Sunday – [1 Corinthians 16](#)

1. On the first day of the week (Sunday) give your firstfruits for the offering.
2. Because there is a wide door for mission work and because of adversaries.
3. Apollos, who showed from the Scriptures that Jesus is the Christ.
4. Aquila and Prisca ([Acts 18:1-3, 18](#)) whose church meets in their house.

Monday – [Mark 15:1-20](#)

1. He did not open His mouth, but was silent as a lamb led to slaughter. [Is 53:7](#)
2. Barabbas who had committed murder in an insurrection.
3. "Crucify him."
4. Jesus was scourged, mocked, crowned with thorns, and struck on the head.

Tuesday – [Mark 15:21-47](#)

1. Forsaken by God, mocked, thirsty, pierced hands and feet, garments divided.
2. To come down from the cross, save Himself, and prove He is the Christ.
3. The temple curtain was rent opening the way to God & a centurion believed
4. Jesus was crucified with the wicked and buried in a rich man's tomb.

Wednesday – [Mark 16:1-11](#)

1. Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, & Salome to anoint Jesus' body
2. They wondered who would roll away the stone, but it was already rolled back
3. Jesus was crucified but He is risen and is no longer in the tomb.
4. To tell the disciples that Jesus is going to Galilee where they will see Him.

Thursday – [Mark 16:12-20](#)

1. To Mary Magdalene who went and told the disciples.
2. The 2 disciples who met Jesus going to Emmaus, but the others didn't believe
3. Go into all the world, proclaim the Gospel, and baptize for salvation.
4. He ascended to heaven to sit at the right hand of God, a position of power.

Friday – [Luke 1:1-38](#)

1. To write an orderly account and narrative of Christ and His work based on eyewitness accounts so that we may have certainty in what we've been taught.
2. A son, but he does not believe Gabriel's message that a child would be born in Elizabeth's old age who would be the forerunner of the Christ.
3. The Son of the Most High God, who will reign over His kingdom forever.
4. After hearing the Holy Spirit will conceive the child, she believes the promise.

Saturday – [2 Corinthians 1](#)

1. By sharing God's comfort which they received when they were afflicted.
2. So that we do not depend on ourselves but upon God and His deliverance.
3. In God's Son, Jesus Christ.
4. At our baptism we were anointed with water and the Holy Spirit.
