Answers for Daily Meditation on the New Testament – Week 19

Sunday – [2 Corinthians 5](#)

1. Our earthly body which is dying, but it will be replaced by our heavenly body.
2. We're of good courage because we will be judged righteous by faith in Christ.
3. As Christ died and rose, by baptism our old man dies and our new man rises.
4. The ministry of reconciling others to God by the message of reconciliation.

Monday – [Luke 4:1-21](#)

1. By God's Word, "Man shall not live by bread alone."
2. By God's Word, "Worship the Lord your God, and him only shall you serve."
3. By God's Word, "You shall not put the Lord your God to the test."
4. Proclaim good news, liberty, & God's favor to the poor, captive, & oppressed.

Tuesday – [Luke 4:22-44](#)

1. Like God's people killed the prophets, they try to kill Jesus too.
2. Because His word possessed authority.
3. By His word, Jesus cast out demons, rebuked fevers, and healed diseases.
4. Preach the good news of the kingdom of God to the towns of God's people.

Wednesday – [Luke 5:1-16](#)

1. Simon Peter's boat which was put out a little from the land.
2. At Jesus word, he put his boat out into the deep and let down his nets.
3. Peter left his boat & net behind and caught men with the net of God's word.
4. In response to the man's prayer of faith that Jesus could heal him.

Thursday – [Luke 5:17-39](#)

1. By showing that He was God by healing the paralytic.
2. Not the self-righteous, but those who needed and wanted healing.
3. When Jesus is with them, they celebrate; when Jesus dies, they fast.
4. The old is the rules of men and the new is the Gospel of God's forgiveness.

Friday – [Luke 6:1-26](#)

1. By showing that it was lawful to do good and save life on the Sabbath.
2. Jesus spent the night in prayer to God.
3. His disciples who were humble in spirit, hungry for His word, wept over their sin, and were persecuted for their faith in Him.
4. Those who preferred wealth, full tables, celebration, and false prophets over the truth of God's word and His Messiah.

Saturday – [2 Corinthians 6](#)

1. The grace of God in Christ which is given to us today and now.
2. Not to be an obstacle by faulty ministry but commendable by faithful ministry
3. Not Paul and his ministry, but the Corinthians who restricted their hearts.
4. Not to be unequally yoked to unbelievers in worship and relationships.
