## Answers for Daily Meditation on the New Testament – Week 20

### Sunday – [2 Corinthians 7](#)

1. Cleanse ourselves from every defilement of body and spirit, bringing holiness
2. Because their godly grief led to repentance, contrition & faith in forgiveness.
3. Godly grief mourns over sin and produces repentance which brings salvation, but worldly grief mourns over sin apart from Christ and produces only despair.
4. Because of the Corinthians' obedience to God & reception of His messenger.

### Monday – [Luke 6:27-49](#)

1. Because when we were God's enemy, He loved & had mercy on us in Christ.
2. First remove the log of sin from our own eye by repenting so we can see.
3. A repentant person does good from his heart; the unrepentant does evil.
4. A house built on a rock that endures a flood & a house built on sand that falls

### Tuesday – [Luke 7:1-23](#)

1. Because the centurion believes Jesus can heal his servant by His word alone.
2. Jesus has compassion on a widow and raises her only son from the dead.
3. He doesn't see Jesus judging the wicked, prophesied for His second coming.
4. Jesus shows that He's fulfilling the Messianic prophecies by healing the blind, lame, deaf, and lepers, raising the dead, and preaching good news to the poor.

### Wednesday – [Luke 7:24-50](#)

1. The greatest prophet since he was the prophesied forerunner of the Christ.
2. When the repentant receive John & Jesus, and the unrepentant do not.
3. By repenting, showing her great love for Jesus, and receiving His forgiveness.
4. By doubting Jesus was a prophet and remaining unforgiving to the woman.

### Thursday – [Luke 8:1-25](#)

1. Several of the women whom Jesus healed and who followed Him as disciples.
2. It should shine prominently so others may see and turn from darkness.
3. Those who hear the word of God and keep it.
4. Jesus, who calms our storms and saves us from death.

### Friday – [Luke 8:26-55](#)

1. In fear, they ask Jesus to depart from them.
2. He longs to stay with Jesus, but Jesus tells him to stay & tell what God did.
3. She believes in Jesus, and her faith acts as a conduit to receive His blessings.
4. Because Jairus heeds Jesus' words, "Do not fear; only believe, & she will live"

### Saturday – [2 Corinthians 8](#)

1. Despite their poverty, they gave generously for the relief of the saints.
2. Though He was rich, He became poor so that we might become rich.
3. Fairness, so that the abundance of God may be shared by all.
4. Most likely Luke, famous for preaching the Gospel, and another brother.
