Answers for Daily Meditation on the New Testament – Week 22

Sunday – [2 Corinthians 11](#)

1. He betrothed them to Christ, but they are led astray by false teachers.
2. Other churches (Macedonia) supported Paul's mission work.
3. They disguise themselves as angels & messengers of light and righteousness.
4. By his sufferings and persecutions for preaching the Gospel to the Church.

Monday – [Luke 11:27-54](#)

1. Those who hear the Word of God and keep it.
2. Because they repented at Jonah's preaching & Jesus is greater than Jonah.
3. They are concerned with outward appearances but not the inner spirit.
4. They burden people with manmade rules, but kill the prophets of God's word

Tuesday – [Luke 12:1-34](#)

1. We are not to fear those who kill the body only, but we are to fear God who can kill both body and soul in hell, but we are not to fear God who values us.
2. The Holy Spirit who teaches us what to say and confess.
3. He hoarded God's blessing and didn't trust God by giving for His kingdom.
4. Because God gives us His kingdom and so we may join the needy in heaven.

Wednesday – [Luke 12:35-59](#)

1. By remaining in the faith through Word & Sacrament and Jesus will serve us.
2. Those who knew but didn't believe will be punished more than the ignorant.
3. Jesus brings division among family between believers and unbelievers.
4. Otherwise it will be too late for us, and we will be imprisoned in hell forever.

Thursday – [Luke 13:1-17](#)

1. Not think they must have deserved it, but repent ourselves lest we perish.
2. God expects them to produce the fruits of repentance, but He is patient with them before His judgment.
3. Because Jesus had healed a crippled woman (done work) on the Sabbath Day
4. The woman was more valuable than an animal he watered on the Sabbath.

Friday – [Luke 13:18-35](#)

1. It starts small but grows in people's hearts until it fills the world.
2. Many will not be saved because of their hypocrisy, evil, and unbelief.
3. People from all the world—east/west/north/south—will recline in the kingdom
4. Jesus continues His journey to Jerusalem where He will die with the prophets

Saturday – [2 Corinthians 12](#)

1. The Lord gave Paul a vision of heaven (Not sky or space but the 3rd heaven)
2. A thorn in the flesh, possibly a health problem or persecution of the body.
3. It made Paul dependent on God's grace and strengthened his faith in Christ.
4. The miracles, wonders, and mighty works which accompanied the Gospel.
