## Answers for Daily Meditation on the New Testament – Week 23

### Sunday – [2 Corinthians 13](#)

1. That on his third visit he will have to chasten them for their continued sin.
2. By using Martin Luther's [Christian Questions with Their Answers](#), LSB p. 329.
3. For their restoration so that he may build them up with the Gospel.
4. Not with the Aaronic Benediction but with the Pauline Benediction.

### Monday – [Luke 14:1-14](#)

1. He shows that unlike himself, they value their animals more than mankind.
2. They will be made lowly and humbled by God.
3. They will be exalted by God.
4. You'll be blessed at the resurrection by doing good to those who can't repay.

### Tuesday – [Luke 14:15-35](#)

1. They will be excluded from the Lord's banquet and the kingdom of heaven.
2. God invites the poor and lowly to fill His house in heaven.
3. Separating from worldly things or unbelievers and suffering persecution.
4. Others see their faith and deeds and taste that the Lord is good.

### Wednesday – [Luke 15](#)

1. The Lord searches for you, brings you to repentance, and rejoices over you.
2. God, you, and the angels who rejoice that God has found a repentant sinner.
3. When we repent, God the Father welcomes us back and celebrates.
4. When we think we've earned God's grace and think sinners don't deserve it.

### Thursday – [Luke 16:1-17](#)

1. He uses his master's money to make friends who will welcome him later.
2. By his shrewdness, he showed the creditors that his master was a gracious man, and also that he believed in his master's grace to him.
3. To bring others into the kingdom of God so they may welcome us in heaven.
4. They tried to justify themselves by the Law to enter heaven, instead of God justifying them by the Gospel.

### Friday – [Luke 16:18-31](#)

1. If the poor man Lazarus returned from the dead and warned them to repent.
2. They have Moses and the Prophets (the Bible) to bring them to repentance.
3. Jesus raised His friend Lazarus, and the chief priests still plotted to kill them.
4. Those who divorce their spouse or those who marry a divorced spouse.

### Saturday – [Galatians 1](#)

1. Not through men but through Jesus Christ and God the Father.
2. Let them be anathema, that is let them be cursed.
3. Not from men or other apostles but as a direct revelation from Jesus Christ.
4. Paul was now preaching the faith which he once tried to persecute & destroy
