Answers for Daily Meditation on the New Testament – Week 24

Sunday – [Galatians 2](#)

1. They agreed on the Gospel. Paul would go to the Gentiles & they to the Jews.
2. Because of Peter's hypocrisy of returning to Jewish ceremonial laws.
3. We are justified by faith in Jesus Christ who kept the Law for us.
4. Our old sinful man was crucified with Christ by baptism and died, but our new man rises to live a new life by faith in Christ who now lives in us.

Monday – [Luke 17:1-19](#)

1. Rebuke him lest he lead others astray, and if he repents, forgive him.
2. We are to serve God by serving others and doing our duty.
3. They go to the Temple and follow the Jewish ceremonial law for cleansing.
4. He returns to worship Jesus and by faith rises with a cleansed heart and life.

Tuesday – [Luke 17:20-37](#)

1. Not in visible signs or earthly rule, but in the hearts of men by faith in Christ.
2. Not indiscreetly but like lightning that lights up all the sky.
3. It will come suddenly & unexpectedly like the flood & destruction of Sodom.
4. Those who didn't desire things of this life but trusted Christ for eternal life.

Wednesday – [Luke 18:1-17](#)

1. Being just and loving, God will certainly answer the prayer of His elect.
2. He proudly compared himself to others and told God of his good deeds.
3. He humbled himself, confessed his sinfulness, and trusted in God's mercy.
4. Reception of the kingdom of God and therefore faith in Christ.

Thursday – [Luke 18:18-43](#)

1. That he couldn't earn it because he hadn't even kept the 1st Commandment.
2. To enter the kingdom of God, but through Christ God does the impossible.
3. That He would be betrayed, flogged, & killed but rise again on the 3rd day.
4. He cried for mercy, and Jesus did what he wanted and restored his sight.

Friday – [Luke 19:1-27](#)

1. He gave 1/2 his possessions to the poor & restored 4 times anything he stole.
2. Because Jesus came to seek and save the lost.
3. Because they trusted their master's mercy and faithfully used his gifts.
4. Because he believed his master was a hard man & didn't trust his mercy.

Saturday – [Galatians 3](#)

1. After believing the Gospel, they reverted to salvation by works of the Law.
2. Abraham believed God's promise of a Messiah, and it was counted as righteousness. We are blessed by faith in Abraham's descendent, Jesus Christ.
3. Those justified by law are cursed; those justified by faith in Christ are blessed.
4. By baptism into Christ we put on Christ and become heirs of God's promises.
