## Answers for Daily Meditation on the New Testament – Week 25

### Sunday – [Galatians 4](#)

1. To keep the Law for us and redeem us who were under the curse of the Law.
2. We are no longer a slave of the Law but adopted sons and heirs of God.
3. Those enslaved by the curse of the Law given at Mt. Sinai.
4. Those freed by the promise of the Gospel given through Jesus Christ.

### Monday – [Luke 19:28-48](#)

1. To fulfill the prophecy of the Messiah. ([Zechariah 9:9](#))
2. The reaction and praise of the crowds for His mighty works.
3. Because He foresees its destruction because of their rejection of Him.
4. Because He drove out their temple thievery & made it to a house of prayer.

### Tuesday – [Luke 20:1-26](#)

1. Their answer would condemn themselves or bring the crowd's condemnation.
2. God, Jewish leaders, prophets, Jesus, the church, and the Gentiles.
3. The religious rulers rejected Jesus, but He becomes the church's foundation.
4. We honor both God and the government by rendering what each is due.

### Wednesday – [Luke 20:27-47](#)

1. They deny the resurrection and were trying to mock it.
2. Moses calls the Lord the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob (present tense).
3. David's son is Jesus Christ who is also the Son of God & therefore his Lord.
4. Because they will be condemned for exalting themselves & their hypocrisy.

### Thursday – [Luke 21:1-19](#)

1. The rich trust in their remaining wealth, but she gave, trusting God to provide
2. The great temple built by Herod will be totally destroyed.
3. False Christs, wars, earthquakes, famines, pestilences, signs from heaven.
4. Jesus will help them give witness and not a hair of their head will perish.

### Friday – [Luke 21:20-38](#)

1. Jesus warns them to flee when they see armies surrounding Jerusalem.
2. The chief priest and the generation who rejected Jesus. ([Matthew 26:63-64](#))
3. The destruction of Jerusalem and all the signs before it.
4. The Last Day of judgment. We stay awake by remaining in faith in Christ.

### Saturday – [Galatians 5](#)

1. We are severed from Christ and lose His grace and righteousness.
2. We are freed to love and serve our neighbor.
3. Sexual immorality, idolatry, sorcery, strife, jealousy, anger, drunkenness
4. Love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness
