Answers for Daily Meditation on the New Testament – Week 26

Sunday – [Galatians 6](#)

1. Restore him in a spirit of gentleness and keep watch lest we fall into sin too.
2. When he helps support the livelihood of his pastor or teacher.
3. Everyone as we have opportunity, especially those of the household of faith.
4. The wounds and scars of persecution for being an apostle of Jesus.

Monday – [Luke 22:1-34](#)

1. The religious rulers who feared the people and Satan who entered Judas.
2. His body given for them on the cross and His blood as the new covenant.
3. The greatest among them is the one who serves as Jesus serves us.
4. That his faith not fail, and when he repents, that he strengthen his brothers.

Tuesday – [Luke 22:35-71](#)

1. Rejection, hostility, and persecution as symbolized by the sword.
2. Anticipation of suffering the cup of God's wrath so He sweat drops of blood.
3. It didn't take place publicly in the day at the Temple but secretly at night.
4. That Jesus is the Son of God.

Wednesday – [Luke 23:1-25](#)

1. They charge Jesus with treason, forbidding taxes, and usurping Caesar.
2. Jesus made no answer but endures their contempt and mockery.
3. Jesus was not guilty of any of their charges, certainly nothing deserving death
4. He released the murderer Barabbas and condemned innocent Jesus to death

Thursday – [Luke 23:26-56](#)

1. Because of the judgment on Jerusalem and on the Last Day for unbelievers.
2. He confessed his sin & turned to Jesus in repentance, and Jesus absolved him
3. Darkness, curtain torn, Roman centurion praised God, crowds repented
4. He believed in Jesus, did not consent to His death, & buried Jesus in his tomb.

Friday – [Luke 24:1-27](#)

1. Of Jesus' prophecy that He would be betrayed, crucified & rise on the 3rd day
2. They thought it an idle tale & didn't believe them but Peter went to the tomb
3. They hoped Jesus would redeem Israel but he was crucified, buried & missing
4. Jesus explains from the OT prophecies his suffering & death before glory.

Saturday – [Ephesians 1](#)

1. Before the foundation of the world, before time began.
2. By redeeming you through the blood of Christ, making known the Gospel which you heard, and sealing it with the Holy Spirit who gives you faith in Christ.
3. The Ephesians' faith in Christ and their love for all the saints.
4. Jesus now reigns as head over all authority in heaven and earth, especially His Church which is His body, both now and forever.
