Answers for Daily Meditation on the New Testament – Week 28

Sunday – [Ephesians 4](#)

1. So that He might fill all things & be present with us in His power everywhere.
2. To equip the saints for ministry, build up the body of Christ, attain unity of faith in Christ, make us mature, and keep us from false teaching and deceit.
3. No corrupt talk but only what is helpful for building others up.
4. Because God in Christ has been kind, tenderhearted, and forgiving to us.

Monday – [John 3:16-36](#)

1. By giving His only Son, Jesus Christ, so that all who believe in Him may live.
2. Not to condemn the world but that the world might be saved through Him.
3. As a friend who rejoices that the bridegroom has His bride, the Church.
4. Whoever believes has eternal life. Unbelievers remain under God’s wrath.

Tuesday – [John 4:1-26](#)

1. Because the Jews looked down on Samaritans for their hybrid religion.
2. Not water from a well, but spiritual enlightenment which gives eternal life.
3. Because Jesus told her things about her sinful life that she had not revealed.
4. The Messiah, the Christ, who would tell us all things.

Wednesday – [John 4:27-54](#)

1. She invited the townspeople to come and see Jesus who might be the Christ.
2. To do the will of His Father and labor for a harvest of souls.
3. That Jesus was the Savior of the world.
4. Before the miracle. After the miracle, his whole household also believed.

Thursday – [John 5:1-18](#)

1. Do you want to be healed?
2. He told the man to get up, take his bed, and walk, and the man was healed.
3. He was still a sinner, but he didn’t know who Jesus truly was.
4. Because He broke their Sabbath rule and called God His Father.

Friday – [John 5:19-47](#)

1. Whoever hears Jesus’ words and believes in Him.
2. Raise the spiritually dead to spiritual life.
3. Raise all the physically dead to either eternal life or eternal death.
4. John the Baptist, God the Father by Jesus’ miracles, the Scriptures, & Moses.

Saturday – [Ephesians 5](#)

1. As imitators of Christ, who loved us and gave Himself as an offering to God.
2. With hymns, singing & giving thanks to God, submitting to one another
3. As the Church submits to Christ, her head, who loves her as His body.
4. As Christ loved the Church & gave Himself for her. As his own body.
