## Answers for Daily Meditation on the New Testament – Week 29

### Sunday – [Ephesians 6](#)

1. By honoring authority, life will often be better and last longer.
2. He is serving Christ his Lord, and his efforts are seen by God.
3. Not men, but against the devil and his spiritual forces of evil.
4. Truth, righteousness of Christ, Gospel, faith, salvation, Word of God, prayer

### Monday – [John 6:1-34](#)

1. Because He perceived the crowds would make Him their bread king.
2. He walks on water and calms His disciples’ fears.
3. Because they only wanted more bread which perishes but not eternal life.
4. Not their work, but God’s work of giving them faith in Jesus.

### Tuesday – [John 6:35-71](#)

1. That all who believe in Jesus Christ will be raised to eternal life.
2. That the man Jesus claimed to be God, the personal union of God and man.
3. That Jesus could give them His flesh/blood to eat/drink (sacramental union).
4. That Jesus is the Holy One of God who has the words of eternal life.

### Wednesday – [John 7:1-24](#)

1. They challenged Him to go to the feast with His disciples & showoff His works
2. They were afraid of the Jews who were seeking to kill Jesus.
3. Jesus had no formal education, but His teaching came from God.
4. They honored circumcision on the Sabbath as a command of Moses but criticized Jesus for healing the whole man on the Sabbath.

### Thursday – [John 7:25-52](#)

1. It was not yet Jesus’ time to suffer and die until He fulfilled all the prophecies.
2. Jesus would die, rise, and return to His Father where they could not come.
3. The Holy Spirit whom Jesus would give to those who believed in Him.
4. Nicodemus, whom Jesus had taught at night. ([John 3:1-21](#))

### Friday – [John 8:1-30](#)

1. Let him who is without sin among you be the first to throw a stone at her.
2. Go and leave your life of sin.
3. The light of the world who gives people the light of eternal life.
4. They will die in their sins because they won’t receive Christ’s sacrifice for sin.

### Saturday – [Philippians 1](#)

1. Because of their partnership in the Gospel and God’s good work in them.
2. Paul is giving witness to the imperial guard & others are more bold to speak.
3. To live and labor for Christ and to die and be with Christ.
4. Standing firm in the faith despite suffering and persecution for Christ.
