Answers for Daily Meditation on the New Testament – Week 31

Sunday – [Philippians 4](#)

1. Rejoice in the Lord and by prayer let their requests be made known to God.
2. What is true, honorable, just, pure, lovely, & commendable from God's Word
3. For the sake of Christ, to be content in every situation, in plenty and in need.
4. They sent offerings to provide for his needs when he worked in Thessalonica.

Monday – [John 11:28-57](#)

1. He was deeply moved at other's grief and wept at the tomb of Lazarus.
2. He calls Lazarus from the grave and raises Him from the dead.
3. That everyone will believe in Him & the Romans will take away their positions
4. That it is better for one man (Jesus) to die than the whole nation perish.

Tuesday – [John 12:1-26](#)

1. Not because he cared about the poor, but because he embezzled offerings
2. Because he was living proof of Jesus' power, and so many believed in Jesus.
3. Because they'd heard the witness of Jesus raising Lazarus from the dead.
4. By His death and resurrection which bears fruit in eternal life for believers.

Wednesday – [John 12:27-50](#)

1. The devil was cast out when Jesus died and rose to draw all people to Himself
2. That many would not believe in Him because their hearts were hardened.
3. They didn't want to be cast out of the synagogue. They loved glory from men.
4. On the Last Day they will be judged for rejecting Jesus and His Words.

Thursday – [John 13:1-20](#)

1. The devil in order to fulfill the prophecy of Scripture ([Psalm 41:9](#))
2. He took the role of a lowly servant and washed His disciples' feet.
3. That they are to follow Jesus' example by serving one another.
4. They are receiving Jesus who sent them and God the Father who sent Jesus.

Friday – [John 13:21-38](#)

1. One of them was going to betray Him.
2. Satan entered into Judas, and he left into the night to implement his betrayal
3. To love one another as He had loved them to identify them as His disciples.
4. That Peter would deny Him 3 times before the rooster crowed the next day.

Saturday – [Colossians 1](#)

1. He has transferred us into the Kingdom of His Son who redeemed us.
2. Christ is the visible image of the invisible God. Christ is before all things (eternal), and all things were made through Him (omnipotent). All the fullness of God dwells in Him. He reconciled us to God by His blood on the cross.
3. He reconciled us to God by His death to present us blameless by faith.
4. The Church is Christ's body, and God gave its stewardship to Paul & pastors.
