Answers for Daily Meditation on the New Testament – Week 34

Sunday – [1 Thessalonians 3](#)

1. Paul sent Timothy to encourage them in their faith during their afflictions.
2. That the tempter would tempt them away from faith in Christ.
3. That the Thessalonians are standing fast in their faith in the Lord.
4. That the Lord would increase their love and faith until Christ comes again.

Monday – [John 19:23-42](#)

1. Jesus gave His mother Mary into the charge of John to take care of her.
2. The redemption of the world was finished; the debt of sin was paid in full.
3. Not one of His bones would be broken; they will look on Him they pierced.
4. Joseph of Arimathea and Nicodemus who were secret disciples of Jesus.

Tuesday – [John 20:1-18](#)

1. The stone was rolled away, and Jesus' body was missing?
2. The tomb was empty except for Jesus' burial cloths.
3. When Jesus calls her by name.
4. Not to cling to Him but go & tell His disciples He was ascending to the Father.

Wednesday – [John 20:19-31](#)

4. So that we may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and have life.

Thursday – [John 21:1-14](#)

1. They decide to go fishing for fish on the Sea of Galilee.
2. After catching nothing all night, the disciples obeyed Jesus & filled their nets.
3. In his excitement, Peter threw himself into the sea and swam to shore.
4. Jesus provides a catch of fish and bread and cooks their breakfast.

Friday – [John 21:15-25](#)

1. To give Peter a chance to confess his love for Jesus after denying Him 3 times.
2. To pastor (shepherd) His flock by confessing Christ even if it meant crucifixion
3. "You follow me!"
4. Because he personally witnessed the words and miracles of Jesus.

Saturday – [1 Thessalonians 4](#)

1. Abstain from sexual immorality, control their body, and live in holiness.
2. Love one another, live quietly, mind their own affairs, work with their hands.
3. The souls of believers whose bodies Christ will raise from the dead.
4. We will be caught up together with them and meet the Lord in the air.
