## Answers for Daily Meditation on the New Testament – Week 35

### Sunday – [1 Thessalonians 5](#)

1. Unexpectedly like a thief in the night and suddenly like labor pains.
2. By continuing in faith and hope in our Lord Jesus Christ who died for us.
3. Those in the church who serve them and are over them in the Lord.
4. Admonish the idle, encourage the fainthearted, help the weak, seek to do good to everyone, rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all things

### Monday – [Acts 1:1-11](#)

1. He presented Himself alive by many proofs and spoke of the kingdom of God.
2. Not to depart Jerusalem but wait for the Father's promised Holy Spirit.
3. To be Christ's witnesses in Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, & the end of the earth.
4. On the Last Day, Jesus will come from heaven in the clouds.

### Tuesday – [Acts 1:12-26](#)

1. The remaining 11, the women, Mary and the brothers of Jesus, totaling 120.
2. He hung himself, the rope broke, and his decaying body fell and ruptured.
3. One who had witnessed Jesus from His baptism to His ascension.
4. The Lord chose through the means of His Church by casting lots or voting

### Wednesday – [Acts 2:1-21](#)

1. The sound of a mighty wind, tongues of fire, & the disciples spoke in tongues
2. Not babbling but speaking in known human languages they hadn't learned.
3. Upon the words of Scripture from the prophet Joel.
4. The time from Christ's ascension to His second coming on the Last Day.

### Thursday – [Acts 2:22-47](#)

1. Upon the crucifixion, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ.
2. David does not speak of himself, since he died and is still buried, but he prophesies that God's Holy One (Christ) will not see decay. ([Psalm 16:8-11](#))
3. The Gospel, repent and be baptized for the forgiveness of sins.
4. For the Jews, for children, and for all Gentiles whom God calls by the Gospel.

### Friday – [Acts 3:1-10](#)

1. They go up to the temple for the regular hour of prayer.
2. He is lame from birth and asks Peter and John to give him alms.
3. In the name of Jesus, Peter heals the man so he can walk.
4. The man leaps & praises God, and the people who witnessed it were amazed.

### Saturday – [2 Thessalonians 1](#)

1. Because they are growing in faith and love even as they endure persecution.
2. When He repays affliction to those who afflict believers in Christ.
3. When Jesus comes on the Last Day with His angels to judge.
4. Eternal destruction in flaming fire away from the presence of the Lord.
