Answers for Daily Meditation on the New Testament – Week 36

Sunday – [2 Thessalonians 2](#)

1. He exalts himself, takes his seat in the temple, & proclaims himself to be God
2. Satan, who works with false signs to deceive people and destroy the truth.
3. The papacy, which claims authority over Scripture and denies justification and salvation by God's grace alone, through faith alone, through Christ alone.
4. The Holy Spirit called you by the Gospel and by His power you believe it.

Monday – [Acts 3:11-26](#)

1. The crucifixion, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ.
2. Repent and turn to God for forgiveness through Jesus Christ.
3. God would raise up a prophet like Moses to whom they should listen.
4. That from Abraham's one offspring all families of the earth would be blessed.

Tuesday – [Acts 4:1-22](#)

1. Because they were teaching and proclaiming in Jesus the resurrection.
2. By the Holy Spirit, Peter preaches that salvation is found in no one but Jesus.
3. Though they were uneducated common men, they had been with Jesus.
4. Peter & John could not but speak of what they had seen & heard about Jesus.

Wednesday – [Acts 4:23-37](#)

1. Though rulers & kings raged against Christ, they plotted in vain against God.
2. The place was shaken, the Holy Spirit filled them, & they preached the word.
3. They were of one faith, believed their possessions were God's, & shared them
4. He sold a field and brought the proceeds to the apostles to distribute.

Thursday – [Acts 5:1-16](#)

1. As punishment for lying to God the Holy Spirit about the price of the field.
2. Because of her hypocritical collusion with her husband about their offering.
3. They held them in high esteem because of their works of mercy.
4. Their miraculous healings testified to God's word & gathered many to hear.

Friday – [Acts 5:17-42](#)

1. An angel opened the prison doors so they could preach in the temple again.
2. "We must obey God rather than men, and we are witnesses of these things."
3. If this is of men, it will fail. If this is of God, you may be fighting against God.
4. They rejoiced for suffering for Jesus' name and continued to preach & teach.

Saturday – [2 Thessalonians 3](#)

1. That the word of the Lord be honored, and they be delivered from evil men.
2. The Lord is faithful. He will guard them from the evil one & direct their hearts.
3. Though he had the right to earn his living from the Gospel, he worked to eat.
4. If one is able bodied, he should not be idle but work to earn his living.
