## Answers for Daily Meditation on the New Testament – Week 37

### Sunday – [1 Timothy 1](#)

1. Paul is the spiritual father of Timothy by passing on the Christian faith to him.
2. To charge certain persons not to teach different doctrine or speculations.
3. To lawbreakers and sinners in need of repentance.
4. Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners and give mercy to believers.

### Monday – [Acts 6](#)

1. Greek Christians complained their widows were slighted in food distribution.
2. Appoint 7 qualified men to serve so the 12 apostles could preach the word.
3. One of the 7 deacons who was doing signs and disputing against the Jews.
4. Blasphemy for speaking against the Temple and the Laws of Moses.

### Tuesday – [Acts 7:1-29](#)

1. God promised to give his offspring the land after freeing them from slavery.
2. Moses, an Israelite who was raised in Pharaoh’s house and Egyptian learning.
3. He struck down an Egyptian who was oppressing an Israelite.
4. They rejected Moses as ruler, and he was exiled in the wilderness.

### Wednesday – [Acts 7:30-60](#)

1. In the wilderness, they rejected Moses and God in preference to false gods.
2. The Lord does not dwell in houses made by man but in heaven and earth.
3. They were the ones who rejected Moses, the prophets, and now the Christ.
4. He commits his spirit to the Lord and prays for Jesus to forgive his enemies.

### Thursday – [Acts 8:1-25](#)

1. Saul persecuted the church, & believers were scattered to Judea & Samaria.
2. Philip, 1 of the 7 deacons, went to Samaria and proclaimed Christ there.
3. He tried to buy the power of the Holy Spirit from the apostles.
4. The buying & selling of ecclesiastical privileges or offices in the papal church.

### Friday – [Acts 8:26-40](#)

1. So he could evangelize one influential Ethiopian, who was a Jewish proselyte.
2. He didn’t understand the prophecy he was reading from the book of Isaiah.
3. Starting with this Scripture passage of the Messiah, he explained to him the good news of Jesus. Philip catechized the Ethiopian in the Christian faith.
4. Seeing water, he desired to apply his faith by being baptized.

### Saturday – [1 Timothy 2-3](#)

1. Pray for all people because God wants all people to be saved & come to Jesus
2. For a woman to teach or have authority over a man, since it was Adam’s duty and all men after him to teach in the household and church.
3. Above reproach, a man, able to teach, gentle, manage his household well.
4. Dignified, not twofaced, not greedy, faithful, manage his household well.
