Answers for Daily Meditation on the New Testament – Week 38

Sunday – [1 Timothy 4](#)

1. They will follow deceitful spirits/liars who forbid marriage & certain foods.
2. By being trained in the words of the faith, good doctrine, and godliness.
3. Teach the faith, be an example of good conduct, read & preach the Scriptures
4. God called Timothy to the office of pastor, recognized by the laying on of hands by other pastors.

Monday – [Acts 9:1-22](#)

1. He was persecuting Christ's body, the Church, by threats and murder.
2. To go to Saul and lay hands on him to regain his sight so he may serve God.
3. Scales fell from his eyes, he was baptized, and filled with the Holy Spirit.
4. He immediately proclaimed Jesus as the Christ, the Son of God.

Tuesday – [Acts 9:23-43](#)

1. The Jews sought to kill him, and the Christians sought to save his life.
2. Barnabas, son of encouragement, spoke on his behalf of his true conversion.
3. He healed the paralytic Aeneas and raised Dorcas (Tabitha) from the dead.
4. The miracles authenticated the apostle's words, and many believed in Jesus.

Wednesday – [Acts 10:1-23](#)

1. In answer to prayer, he was to send men to fetch Peter to hear of the Lord.
2. Following ceremonial law, he was not to eat animals God declared unclean.
3. As God could declare foods clean, he could declare Gentiles clean by Jesus.
4. 3 Gentiles knocked on the door & the Holy Spirit told Peter to go with them.

Thursday – [Acts 10:24-48](#)

1. He said he should call no one unclean but all were worthy to hear the Gospel.
2. Jesus Christ crucified, risen, and ascended for the forgiveness of sins.
3. The Holy Spirit who was manifested in the people speaking other languages.
4. That they be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ.

Friday – [Acts 11:1-18](#)

1. The circumcision party who believed that Gentiles must first become Jewish and be circumcised before joining in Christian fellowship.
2. The vision, God's declaration of clean, the Spirit's urging to go with Gentiles.
3. The Holy Spirit came upon the Gentiles like He came upon them at Pentecost.
4. To the Gentiles also God has granted repentance that leads to life in Christ.

Saturday – [1 Timothy 5](#)

1. Their children and grandchildren, especially when they are believers.
2. Older widows may be enrolled for support; younger widows may remarry.
3. With honor and deserving wages.
4. On the charge of at least 2 or 3 witnesses, he should be rebuked publicly.
